AFTERNOON

SITE I (Diamond Head on the island of Oahu, HI)

.... hard, natural, rugged..... vertical ups..... vertical  
 downs..... up and over.....

SITE II (Buenos Aires, Argentina)

.... initial feeling of up, vertical, hard.... colors of grays  
 and bluish gray.... then a feeling of down and curving  
 up... in the curve there was a feeling of something white  
 and grainy, but not snow.... then a feeling of vertical  
 again, vertical up, vertical up, and vertical with a right  
 angle across (structure/structures)..... away from the verticals  
 the color green dominated.

OVERALL: The morning sessions seemed rather hit-and-miss. The afternoon  
 sessions would appear to be more "together". I definitely felt a great deal of  
 confidence when trying to locate the <sup>contingent</sup> of Site II.... When trying
