SESSION SUMMARY

SITE: Walled City and Fortress in desert (Iran)

..... perceived that site consisted of tall vertical cliffs or mountain of natural, rough texture... colors of browns, earthones, orange... feeling of warm.... something at base felt curved, concave, dark.... perception of angles, squares, rectangles, structures..... structures at the base of this tall vertical formation..... site was very quiet (site abandoned in 1850) with only the sounds of birds chirping perceivable..... the only A.I. was a feeling of tall, vertical, but this was fairly weak and did not have significant impact. While sketching the site in the left brain mode there was a temptation to "label" the site a Southwest Cliff Dwelling, but this thought was regarded by viewers as pure AOL and discarded* cliff dwellings are located above the base of cliffs, not at the base).
