1. (S/NF/SK) TASKING: Same as CRV-1
2. (S/NF/SK) SESSION: (Monitor 'front-loaded' with CRV-1 data.) Source seemed to be in an extraordinarily perceptible/receptive state. After describing site in S.I., ~~was~~ and moving through S.P., monitor cued source with "inside structures something should be visible."
3. (S/NF/SK) Summary: Site is a land-water interface with a bridge-like structure as well as other structures nearby. There is a large, cavernous building at the site. Inside, there are pungent chemical smells, the sound of heavy equipment moving about and echoes produced because of the size and openness of the building. There are cylindrical objects; ~~ridges~~ ^{ridges}, unceasingly and heavy (AOL - drums). There are also tracked vehicles and long, silvery, smooth cylindrical objects which produce a sensation of ~~rapid~~ ^{swift} movement (AOL - ~~against~~ ^{against} ~~mainly~~ ^{mainly} ~~projectiles~~).

Site seems to source to be a ~~at~~ warehouse-type
place used to stockpile equipment.

4. (S/NF/SK) ~~FEEDBACK~~ FEEDBACK: Throughout session, monitor provided source with ~~possible~~ positive reinforcement words. ~~They~~ beginning after SI description of site, i.e., "this seems to be the site"; "you're doing fine", etc.
- At end of session, monitor told source that she seemed to have done an outstanding job, but that there was really no way to confirm this until ops officer reviewed session ~~transcript~~ transcript.
