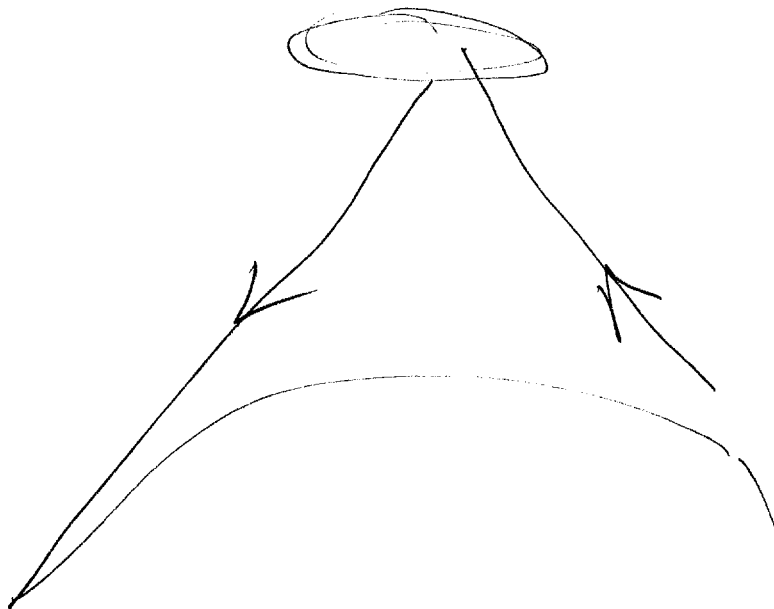

Summary, superstructure is a "receiving/transmitter" site virtually unmanned. Structure below ground has several levels with a tunnel off to the side. People in lower structure have slightly drinkable features and wear what appears to be civilian type jump suits (there is no indication of rank or the like). There is a large room below ground with a tall ceiling, exposed struts and a scaffolding-type frame. The people in this lower structure control a piece of sophisticated ^{air} weaponry (An Arch-like device) that can be directed away from the earth to an object in the atmosphere that deflects it back to the earth in a different location.

A strike capability is associated with this site.
