Site involves a white or light colored boxlike container with a lid, hinged along one edge, that opens up. Inside is a smooth, black, shiny rounded (perhaps spherical) object with protruberances that give it a sparsely spiny appearance. Object is heavy for its size and dense. Is inert but with an active ingredient that will cause it to perform its function when its owners desire and requisite conditions are met. Object is presently placed or stored in a small room or closet in a larger, grey building that has a feeling of permanence and solidity (ADL of a campus building at an ivy league school). Outside the building is manicured landscaping, or at least a tended grass area with trees and walkways. The building seems to be secluded in some way from the urban area in which it is located, like a private preserve or enclave. The box is not locked up in its room inside the building, but is behind a closed door. Whoever placed it there is fairly confident that no one will meddle with it; and they are probably correct because there are few, if any people present, and when they are, they do not frequent this small room. A person with a black silk-appearing shirt may be associated with the site.
