


Subject: Results of SRV session for the week beginning 8 December, 1986.

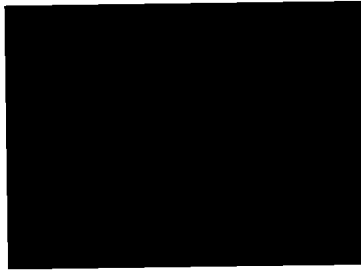
1. Session Summary: Site is a wide, low, squarish brick building with a sloping grey/green roof, situated in a wide open area of very flat land.
