(S/NF) As a result of discussions and decisions at the 7 September 1990 MIB, I am terminating today the previous agreements (references above) that transferred operational control of the SUNSTREAK Program to ODCSINT for a special test/evaluation period. I appreciate your staff's efforts, particularly those of SG1I USA, and accept your offer to have available to assist DIA in follow-on actions regarding the program. However, with the special test/evaluation period over, administrative and operational control of the SUNSTREAK Program and its fiscal and personnel resources reverts to DIA. I have asked the DIA Executive Director, to oversee our subsequent SUNSTREAK Program actions on my behalf.
