There may be plans and intentions to move the prisoners or keep them on the move. The reason for this is unknown at this time.

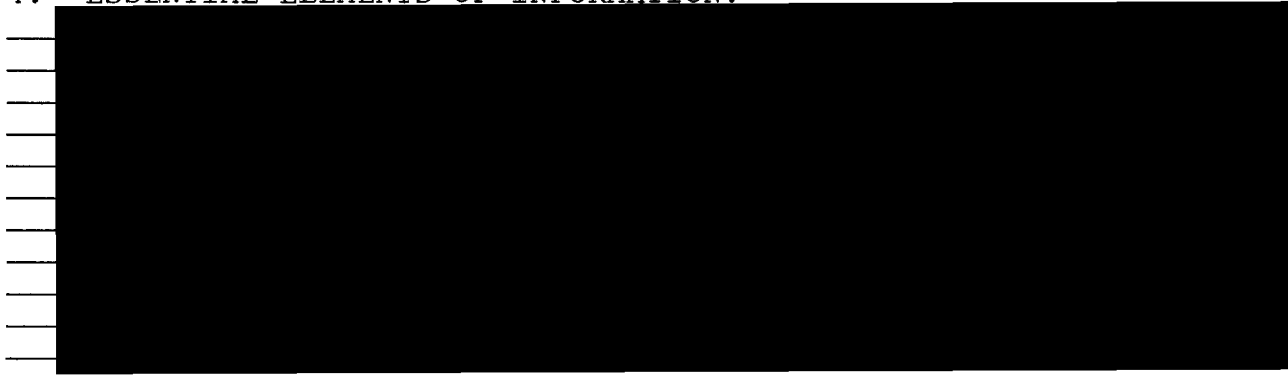
