## RESULTS:

- 1. The target site is a long, very large, triangular-topped structure in an open, spacious area (no other structures close by, but lots of tall trees). It has one main end as its "front". I do not find any sides to it, almost as though either the sides are open, the triangular top part reaches the ground, or both.
- 2. The air is very cool and crisp, like moutain air. The land is uneven, with the structure located on a high point of the land.
- 3. The structure carries feelings of religious, scientific, business natures, and there is also a feeling of strong architectural interest about it. Its one-main-ended triangular shape and its large size drove strong AOL's of both a large mountain chalet, and the Air Force Chapel.
