Impressions were of a port area, and moving and unloading things. An analytic/signal impression of containers was present.

A search was then conducted on 5 ships;

Impressions were that four ships were either clean or could not be detected against. A fifth vessel, later identified by the monitor as the

seemed to have indications of contraband aboard - at 2 location immediately at the stern and approximately water line level. (See ~~the~~ diagram) Material was in the form of ~~blocks~~ hard brick-shaped blocks, may have been wrapped in plastic, but was rolled up in loose fabric and stuffed neatly into a space between two vertical metal surfaces or walls.
