Summary of Information

The activity is to take place within a city that is either old or has an old section to it. It "feels" European but this may be the flavor of the section per se vice the city itself. The specific location is a place where the sidewalk is substantially wider on the street corner than along the side of the buildings. The sidewalk is rather narrow and abuts right up to the buildings and the street. On one particular street corner, there is a tall, dark green lamp post which sits isolated from the structures, benches etc. around it. The glass at the top is cloudy and gives off a dull light. Somewhere associated with this location are the characters "W--D 135" or "-WD- 135". These characters are small, black or a dark color and sit on a white background. There is not alot of pedestrian activity in this location nor are there many vehicles. This particular street corner has a peculiar rounded "v" shape to it. nearest buildings are constructed of a combination of shaped and natural stone. This locale is being watched by one or two individuals. They are sitting above the corner and have to look down at an angle to see the lamp post. At some point there is a loud "crack" sound, which causes a lot of confusing activity.
