2. (S/NF/SK) Source Tasking: The Source was instructed to review session #2, to reacquire the target building, and then to begin the session with a movement exercise so as to assist in sketching. Because the Source's sketching was proceeding in a very painstaking, labored manner the monitor decided upon another avenue of approach (to meet the "supporting evidence" requirement); the Source was instructed to acquire and describe the "person who possesses the document". SESSION SUMMARY

SESSION: 14 SEPTEMBER 1987, 1017-1058 HRS

The target was a document located somewhere inside a building. Had some difficulty acquiring the building, but seemed to pick up the signal when asked to describe the person in possesion of the document. This person wears thick glasses, dresses somewhat conservatively, preferring the color brown and shades thereaf. He looks and acts like the typical "absent-minded professor". Mentally, this person is not very organized. His thoughts and interests are bouncing around in his head like a room full of bouncing ping-pong balls. I can imagine this person being so engrossed in his thoughts that he often blindly walks into walls.

I suspected that this target was a Utility Assessment at some point into the second session.
