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#### PROTOCOL

#### JOINT COMMUNICATIONS SERIES

The Joint Communications (JC) series will involve the interaction of our remote viewers acting as send as well as receivers.

One remote viewer will be designated as the "seller" while the remaining two viewers will be the designated receivers of information during a specific time window set lide for this purpose. The time window will normally be from 10 0 hrs to 1045 hrs.

Immediately following the session, the two remove viewers who acted as receivers will finalize their independent ummaries with supportive sketches.


The two remote viewers who acted as receivers will then compare their composite findings—and agree upon a prioritied listing of key responses to the target.

In all instances, the remote viewers acting as ceivers <u>must</u> address the most significant target aspects. These will be identified as a <u>distinct</u> and <u>separate</u> entry in the <u>mmary</u>.

Immediately following the session, the <u>sender</u> will also prepare a short summary of his "sending" activities that will reflect areas of concentration including the feeling/sensation ound aspect associated with the target.

After the four targets in this phase are complete: a <u>target-RV</u> script/sketch judging procedure will occur. All four targets will be placed in random order and analysts will attemp to identify their proper order based on the RV data. This is a milar to the procedure used in the December 1992 communication experiment.

Important Note: The sender(s) cannot discuss the target until after the judging process is completed. The two recovers cannot discuss their data with anyone else until after the judging process is completed.
