

SUBJECT: Results of SRV session for project "P" DATE: 26 Mar 87

SUMMARY: The following narrative summarizes the content of the actual session transcript:

The site is a large, square, cavernous structure which is mostly empty inside. The inside area is very damp, chilly, and has an oily smell. There is some kind of metal plate on the floor, covering what seems to be a large hole. There are hanging "things" overhead, with lots of room above them. These are strongly suggestive (AOL) of very large block & tackle units.

The inside of the structure is empty except for a very large metallic object which gives the impression (AI) of being VERY heavy. Other than the fact that this object has a generally curved shape and is, for the most part, OD in color, I have not been able to gain any more EEI about it.

RVER'S SELF CRITIQUE: The following summary was made after the RVer reviewed his session transcript in order to write this report:

There is a strong desire to make this into a repair shop for tanks. I am suspicious of this conclusion, however, caused by the ease with which everything fit too neatly into place. I am confident that the raw data provided is accurate, but I suspect that there is a very heavy analytic overlay, caused by the strong similarities of the actual site to the identification I was not able to escape giving it.




Site is located in a rolling, hilly, temperate area with fairly heavy mature vegetation. [Site reminds me of Switzerland, N. Italy, or other similar central European locale. 1 A structure located so as to overlook a depreession in the terrain is of interest. It is squarish, cement, and unstriking in appearance, but over the years has become integrated into the environment. It is often taken for granted by the natives, who often pass it in their daily routine, but don't even think anyting about it any There are people inside the structure who are sitting and waiting, perhaps even watching, anticipating some sort of event or arrival. They have an air of being some how outside the social milieu in which they are now located--either foreigners, or people who feel in some way superior to those in the society around them--removed from it, distant, not bound by its strictures and rules. They are cynical, pragnmatic, convinced that the "ends justify the means"; here in the structure they are all males, but there are females associated with them who take an active part in whatever they all are involved in. There is an extra-regional, perhaps international aspect to their interests. They fell secure where they are, but in their travels do not always feel so. They presently await the next step in a sequence of events which they have anticipated for a while. the purveyance of some item or material which they need for "leverage" in accomplishing another, not directly related objective. Something along the lines of valuable "trading materials" or "barter items," which will be "converted" into power or influence that can be directed at accomplishing their true ends. One individual is swarthy, has a mustache, and is wearing a short-sleeved, perhaps khaki, shirt. He is fairly stocky, and seems to be the one to whom others defer for decisions and judgement. He is agitated, but pretending to be calm and relaxed to maintain an image others have of him of always being in control of the situation.
