Body in Bay Could Be Linked to Plane Crash

After examining a body found this week in Chesapeake Bay near St. Mary's shores, state authorities were trying to determine if the dead woman was the pilot of a plane that disappeared last month while en route to Anne Arundel County. "There is a chance, but we're not a hundred percent sure until we get the dental records," Dr. Margarita Korell said Thursday from the Maryland medical examiner's office.

The body, spotted Monday morning by a boater about two miles east of Spring Ridge, was that of a woman who had been dead for "several weeks," Korell said. Dressed in shirt and pants, the body was "basically whole," but decomposition prevented authorities from pinpointing the time of death. On Oct. 4, Rosa Maria Tames Gonzales, a 30year-old student airplane pilot from Annapolis, failed to return to Lee Airport in Edgewater with a 1973 Piper Cherokee during a round trip to Delaware. Investigators had concentrated their search for the plane and pilot in the Easton area, where the plane was scheduled to make a brief stop, and off Cove Point after a fisherman reported hearing a plane engine that day and a loud splash.
