Sid Hurwich has a secret and although Israel gave him its Medal of Honor for it, he wont say what it is.

The self-taught electronics expert, who suil does appliance repairs at home, knows it scrambled Ugandan President Idi Amin's radar and allowed Israeli aircraft to land undetected during the raid on Entebbe.

That's why he was awarded the medal.

Now 63. a widower, father of two children and grandfahis device not as, an invention, but simply as "a different use for one of the oldest basic principles of electricity - and it stops bombs from going off." .
