- 1. (C) A review of actions taken in support of efforts to free BG Dozier has been initiated. The initial steps are the formulation of questions for the Phase 2 debrief of BG Dozier (Incl 1) and information to be obtained elsewhere (Incl 2).
- 2. (C) Of equal importance is an analysis of the use of GRILL FLAME collection in future events of this type. Specific areas to be covered:
 - a. Is GRILL FLAME collection effective for real-time events?
 - b. What targeting methods are most effective in real-time events?
 - c. How does GRILL FLAME information enter the intelligence chain?
 - d. Where should GRILL FLAME information be evaluated?
- e. What type organization if any should be assembled to handle GRILL FLAME information regardless of originator?
 - f. What additional security requirements, if any, are necessary?
 - g. What planning should be initiated for the future?
- 3. (U) As specific issues are completed a formal report will be provided. The initial target date for completion is 1 June 1982.
