The subject appears to be a middle-aged person, about 55 years of age, of medium-build, brown hair and blue eyes. His hair is currently white and short; he occasionally wears glasses. He is of average intelligence; he has difficulty handling money. He speaks with some sort of melodious accent. He likes music and frequents clubs.

He is believed to have a criminal record that reflects a previous involvement in murder and drug involvement.

He has changed his name to "Wayne" (phonetic); he will change his name again.

The name "Rosemary" surfaced to describe a person known as his sister. The additional names of "Maggie and Lynn" surfaced to identify female acquaintances who appear willing to assist him.

His current cover story is related to the medical profession and the use of an apparatus such as a microscope.

He feels a need to socialize despite; he intends to keep on the move intermittently.

He is believed to be located in a warm, tropical, and somewhat coastal, tourist, coastal area frequented by young people and situated in a forested area with flowers.

Additional efforts to pinpoint his current location indicated that he is located in the Everglades of Florida. Attempts to further identify an exact location revealed that he can possibly be found in the areas of North Point, Cape Sable, and Everglades City.
