Countryside <u>surrounding</u> explosion area is flat, open. rolling, and grassy, with some hard, grey, rectangular structures scattered about. These structures are functional and official. There is a sense of a sloping-down landform that is steep and rocky, "like" a cliff. The site is separated off in some way, purposely kept in open terrain. Another structure seems to be white, rounded, angled, curving, smooth, concrete and solid. Bk of Chernobyl. Something is present that is red, yellow, and orange, and there is further am exhaust smell present reminiscent of JP4. Impression of a helicopter in the vicinity. There is an impression that the cause of the explosion originated from a distance, "like" a group of people coordinated and organized, then "launched" it, or in some way sent it in. Impression of Soviet involvement in some way, but setting seems to be third world. Impression that an airport is involved. AOL/S of rocket launched from a distance. Impression of possible body or course of water at base of down-sloping geologic landform near grouping of structures.
