- i. I wish to express some reservations about the judgment that the counterinsurgency light in South Vietner cannot be won so long as the Mgo family rotains leadership, as is not forth in the ONE nemorandum to you of 3 September.
- 2. Prior to the Buddhist controversy, it was generally agreed that the combined South Victomoso-125 effort was beginning to show signs of progress in the enti-Commaist atruggle. Time was bringing steady improvement to the civilian and military sectors of the Victomoso government, and the strategic hamlet program, in particular, accord to be getting off the ground.
- I. The impact of the Suddhist affair on the prosecution of the anti-Communist struggle may not prove to be lasting. The consensus of observers is that recent political developments have not deeply affected the bulk of the population residing in the countryside. The government demonstrated firmers, which the Vistascus people traditionally respect, and as now engaged in a comprehensive effort to normalize the situation. It may even be that the emergence of what to an open position of influence will enhance the government's efforts to galvanize the war offert.
- 4. International reporturations over the Audibist controversy probably will be short-lived and of little rest consequence. The That government is now acting behind the stenes to undertut Caylongs efforts to organize Southeast Asian consure of South Vietnam, and even Cambodia-for pragnatic reasons of trade-is not anxious to take further steps which would antagonize the Diem povernment.

5. In short, I do not believe one can rule out all possibility of winning the war under a vgc administration. In viewing the natter, it should be remembered that it took the British nine years of intensive effort to beat down the Communist rebellion in Walaya, where the problems were less than those of Vietnam.
