(U//FCVC) BACKGROUND: Senator Inouye (D-HI) and Senator Reid (D-Nev) sponsored language in the July 2008 Supplemental Appropriation bill for DIA to investigate foreign advanced aerospace weapon threats from the present out to 40 years in the future.
