

For your information, captioned motion picture is being produced by The <u>Mirisch Corporation</u>, Los Angeles, <u>California</u>, and is based on an original screenplay by Alan R. Trustman. Sex is both explicit and implied throughout the story and is especially apparent in the romantic relationship between the girl and Crown. Rock is fully aware of the methods being used by the girl to extract admissions from Crown. The Story ends when the girl and the FBI are outwitted by Crown, who flies to Brazil, leaving a final invitation for the girl to join him in that country.

He has also tended bar, sold encyclopedias, made sandals and been a runner in a Port Arthur, Texas brothel - going from one job to the next, trying to run from his dreary, dreadful past.

> STEVE has been running that way ever since he was a kid. His father began it by running out on the family while STEVE was still a baby. Mrs. MC QUEEN farmed STEVE out to an uncle in Missouri. At 12 STEVE fled to New York. He later lived with his mother and new stepfather in California, but that was no improvement. He spent so much time in the streets and so little time in school that his mother sent him away for rehabilitation. He promptly ran away and wound up in jail. Even in the Marines, STEVE wouldn't stay puthe spent 41 days in the brig for going AWOL.




