Please be advised that the Record/Information Dissemination Section (RIDS) is operating at reduced staffing levels amidst the ongoing COVID-19 national emergency. The enclosed FOIPA release represents a work product that could be generated for you under these unprecedented circumstances. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to release as much information, to as many requesters as possible, as this emergency continues.

FBI FOIPA Addendum

As referenced in our letter responding to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request, the FBI FOIPA Addendum provides information applicable to your request. Part 1 of the Addendum includes standard responses that apply to all requests. Part 2 includes standard responses that apply to requests for records about individuals to the extent your request seeks the listed information. Part 3 includes general information about FBI records, searches, and programs.

Part 1: The standard responses below apply to all requests:

- (i) **5 U.S.C. § 552(c).** Congress excluded three categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIPA [5 U.S.C. § 552(c)]. FBI responses are limited to those records subject to the requirements of the FOIPA. Additional information about the FBI and the FOIPA can be found on the www.fbi.gov/foia website.
- (ii) Intelligence Records. To the extent your request seeks records of intelligence sources, methods, or activities, the FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), (b)(3), and as applicable to requests for records about individuals, PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(1), (b)(3), and (j)(2)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records is itself a classified fact protected by FOIA exemption (b)(1) and/or would reveal intelligence sources, methods, or activities protected by exemption (b)(3) [50 USC § 3024(i)(1)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that any such records do or do not exist.

Part 2: The standard responses below apply to all requests for records on individuals:

- (i) Requests for Records about any Individual—Watch Lists. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of any individual's name on a watch list pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(7)(E) and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that watch list records do or do not exist.
- (ii) Requests for Records about any Individual—Witness Security Program Records. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records which could identify any participant in the Witness Security Program pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(3) and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(3), 18 U.S.C. 3521, and (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.
- (iii) Requests for Records for Incarcerated Individuals. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records which could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any incarcerated individual pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.

Part 3: General Information:

- (i) Record Searches. The Record/Information Dissemination Section (RIDS) searches for reasonably described records by searching systems or locations where responsive records would reasonably be found. A standard search normally consists of a search for main files in the Central Records System (CRS), an extensive system of records consisting of applicant, investigative, intelligence, personnel, administrative, and general files compiled by the FBI per its law enforcement, intelligence, and administrative functions. The CRS spans the entire FBI organization, comprising records of FBI Headquarters, FBI Field Offices, and FBI Legal Attaché Offices (Legats) worldwide; Electronic Surveillance (ELSUR) records are included in the CRS. Unless specifically requested, a standard search does not include references, administrative records of previous FOIPA requests, or civil litigation files. - (ii) **FBI Records.** Founded in 1908, the FBI carries out a dual law enforcement and national security mission. As part of this dual mission, the FBI creates and maintains records on various subjects; however, the FBI does not maintain records on every person, subject, or entity.
- (iii) Requests for Criminal History Records or Rap Sheets. The Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division provides Identity History Summary Checks often referred to as a criminal history record or rap sheet. These criminal history records are not the same as material in an investigative "FBI file." An Identity History Summary Check is a listing of information taken from fingerprint cards and documents submitted to the FBI in connection with arrests, federal employment, naturalization, or military service. For a fee, individuals can request a copy of their Identity History Summary Check. Forms and directions can be accessed at www.fbi.gov/about-us/cjis/identity-history-summary-checks. Additionally, requests can be submitted electronically at www.edo.cjis.gov. For additional information, please contact CJIS directly at (304) 625-5590.
- (iv) **National Name Check Program (NNCP).** The mission of NNCP is to analyze and report information in response to name check requests received from federal agencies, for the purpose of protecting the United States from foreign and domestic threats to national security. Please be advised that this is a service provided to other federal agencies. Private Citizens cannot request a name check.

EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552

- (b)(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified to such Executive order;
- (b)(2) related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency;
- (b)(3) specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than section 552b of this title), provided that such statute (A) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on issue, or (B) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld;
- (b)(4) trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential;
- (b)(5) inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency;
- (b)(6) personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;
- (b)(7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

- (d)(5) information compiled in reasonable anticipation of a civil action proceeding;
- (j)(2) material reporting investigative efforts pertaining to the enforcement of criminal law including efforts to prevent, control, or reduce crime or apprehend criminals;
- (k)(1) information which is currently and properly classified pursuant to an Executive order in the interest of the national defense or foreign policy, for example, information involving intelligence sources or methods;
- (k)(2) investigatory material compiled for law enforcement purposes, other than criminal, which did not result in loss of a right, benefit or privilege under Federal programs, or which would identify a source who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence:
- (k)(3) material maintained in connection with providing protective services to the President of the United States or any other individual pursuant to the authority of Title 18, United States Code, Section 3056;
- (k)(4) required by statute to be maintained and used solely as statistical records;
- (k)(5) investigatory material compiled solely for the purpose of determining suitability, eligibility, or qualifications for Federal civilian employment or for access to classified information, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(6) testing or examination material used to determine individual qualifications for appointment or promotion in Federal Government service the release of which would compromise the testing or examination process;
- (k)(7) material used to determine potential for promotion in the armed services, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished the material pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence.

After Detective took measurements for positioning of the body, the Oregon Funeral Service removed the body. It should be noted that I observed a small bindle with white powdery substance still partially inside (the plastic was torn open) which was located just under the body in the area of the trunk. I collected that, and listed it on Evidence Receipt #466011 as Item #1. Additionally within approximately two feet of the body, we discovered an extinguished Marlboro cigarette butt, this additionally was placed on the evidence receipt previously listed. REMAINS FOUND NEAR RIVER IDENTIFIED AS WOMAN, 37 Michael A. Barber; P-I Reporter

Skeletal remains found near the Tye River in far northeast King · County were identified last night as those of a 37-year-old San Juan County woman reported missing in May.

Dawn R. Jennings was identified through dental records, the King County medical examiner's office said.

A spokeswoman for the San Juan County Sheriff's Department confirmed last night that Jennings had been reported missing May 11, but she would not provide other information.

Authorities said Jennings' death does not appear to be related to suspected serial murders in Snohomish County.

A Snohomish County sheriff's detective who watched King County investigators probe the site where Jennings' remains were found east of Skykomish saw "no linkage" with the Snohomish County killings, Snohomish sheriff's spokesman Elliott Woodall said last night.

"There is enough of a difference to the scene to suggest that it is a singular incident, versus being tied to the other ones," King County Detective Jim Doyon said.

Doyon, a veteran of the unsolved Green River serial slayings of at least 49 women in the early 1980s, declined to reveal what evidence pointed authorities away from the other deaths.

Jennings' remains were found by hikers Sunday afternoon down a steep slope from Old Cascade Highway, about 2 miles from Highway 2.

The discovery triggered concern because the site is within 30

minutes' drive from at least 12 sites of unsolved murders in South Snohomish County.

Last month, Snohomish County Sheriff James Scharf launched a serial murder investigation after dismembered remains of at least two men and a woman were found earlier this year. Deputies determined that several killers were responsible for the 12 unsolved deaths in the past eight years.

"The strongest indication we have of any kind of serial activity is in a group of three, possibly four victims, found at three different locations," Woodall said.

The common trait they share is dismemberment:

On March 27, the skull of Sun Nyo Lee, 36, Bothell, reported missing June 1990, was found along the High Bridge Road, south of Monroe.

On March 26, a clump of a man's brown, curly hair, ear and scalp tissue were found near the same location.

On Feb. 28, a man's severed right leg was found along the Skykomish River near Startup.

On June 7, 1987, the dismembered torso of a man was found two miles east of Gold Bar. An arm, two legs and a severed head washed away in the river were later found.

King County police are looking into the possibility that Lee's slaying is related to the deaths of Diana O. Hopkinson, 22, of South Seattle, whose remains were found scattered in plastic bags near Ellensburg in 1990, and Rhonda Hanke, 22, of Portland, who was shot to death and dumped off Interstate 90 at Snoqualmie Pass in December, 1989.

Both Lee and Hanke had been previously arrested in prostitution-related incidents. Lee's and Hopkinson's bodies were dismembered.

Another group of Snohomish victims, possibly slain by a

different serial killer, Woodall said, includes:

Robin Maria Kenworthy, 20, of Seattle, found Oct. 22, 1988, partially buried at a former logging site along Reiter Road north of Index. Police classified her death as due to "homicidal violence."

Jennifer Anne Burnetto, 32, of Tacoma, found nearby on Aug. 25, 1990. She had been stabbed and dumped at the end of a logging road nine miles northeast east of Index.

Commonalities include the proximity of the dump sites to Index and the women's similar lifestyles. Woodall said each victim had ties to street life, drugs and prostitution.

A third serial slayer is thought to be responsible for the 1987 Thanksgiving Day slayings of Jay Roland Cook, 20, of British Columbia, found strangled beneath High Bridge south of Monroe. His girlfriend, Tanya van Cuylenberg, 18, was found shot to death near Burlington, Skagit County.

She had been sexually assaulted.

Woodall said four other unsolved slayings between June 5, 1983 and Aug. 25, 1990 are under investigation because they occurred in the same time frame. gh/pm

HELP SOUGHT IN PROBE OF WOMAN'S SLAYING TIMES STAFF: TIMES NEWS SERVICES

King County police are looking for people who may have been in contact with Rhonda Hanke, the 22-year-old Portland woman whose body was found earlier this week along Interstate 90.

Police are asking that anyone who may have had recent contact with Hanke call King County police at 296-7530 during the day or 296-3311 evenings and weekends.

Police spokeswoman Pamela Bailey said Hanke was seen frequently in Seattle on Aurora Avenue North and North 85th Street. Hanke was arrested in Seattle in November on prostitution charges and pleaded guilty, police said.

Hanke's partly-clad body was found Tuesday morning about five miles west of Snoqualmie by a crew of Department of Transportation workers. Police believe the body of the woman, who had been shot several times, had been there for a few days.

SNOQUALMIE PASS

A woman who was found shot in the head yesterday along Interstate 90, five miles west of Snoqualmie Pass, has been identified as Rhonda Hanke, 22, of Portland, according to the King County medical examiner's office.

Hanke's body was found by state Department of Transportation crews about 9 a.m., just a few feet off the westbound highway, said county police Sgt. Harlan Bollinger.

King County police officer Cecil Ray said homicide detectives and county medical examiner's personnel determined that Hanke had suffered multiple gunshot wounds and had been dead two to four days.

DISMEMBERMENT KILLINGS OF 2 AREA WOMEN ARE FOCUS OF 3 POLICE PROBES Michael A. Barber; P-I Reporter

Two King County women now have been identified as victims of dismemberment slayings that police in three counties are investigating.

On Tuesday, butchered remains found a year ago near Ellensburg in Kittitas County were identified as Diana O. Hopkinson, 22, of South Seattle. The same day, Snohomish County authorities identified a skull found two weeks ago near the Snoqualmie River as that of Sun Nyo Lee, 36, of Bothell.

The identifications have led investigators from King, Kittitas and Snohomish counties to share information in hopes of finding that both slayings were committed by the same person.

And investigators are checking for links between Hopkinson's death and the Dec. 27, 1989, slaying of Rhonda Hanke, 22, of Portland, Ore. She was shot in the head, and her body was dumped off Interstate 90 near Snoqualmie Summit.

Snohomish County Sheriff's Department spokesman Elliott Woodall said his agency had shared information about Lee for more on Hopkinson and Hanke.

Investigators said the three cases had several things in common: Hopkinson and Hanke apparently were involved in the drug culture; Lee and Hanke had been arrested in prostitution-related incidents; and Lee's and Hopkinson's bodies were dismembered.

"It is rare to find dismembered (bodies) in the same time frame in relatively close proximity, " King County police spokesman Tony Burtt said.

No solid suspects have emerged in any of the investigations.

Kittitas County Prosecutor/Coroner David Pitts said Hopkinson's remains were found March 3, 1990, but were not identified until recently, when they were matched with her dental records.

Her body was chopped up and scattered in plastic bags in sagebrush at a tourist viewpoint off Interstate 82 near Ellensburg, Pitts said.

"Not all of her was found," he said. Coyotes had dragged off some of the bags.

"We used a professional tracker to find the last bag," he said.

Authorities were unable to determine how or where she was killed.

Hopkinson's last known address was an apartment at the Aqua Marine Apartments in the 9500 block of Rainier Avenue South, where she was last seen alive in October 1989, police said. She shared the dwelling with a male friend, investigators said.

On Wednesday, King County detectives searched the apartment. The current occupants allowed police to search without a warrant, Burtt said. He declined to reveal what police were looking for or what was recovered.

Burtt said Hopkinson was from Massachusetts and moved to Seattle in the summer of 1989. She was known to drive a dark blue, 1989 Isuzu Pup truck with California license plates. The truck was found abandoned at a tire shop several blocks from the apartment shortly after she disappeared.

Although Hopkinson was last seen alive in Seattle, King County police are investigating because her relatives, from Massachusetts, reported her disappearance to them last November.

Hopkinson's relatives declined to comment yesterday.

Bill Haglund, chief investigator for the King County medical examiner, said Hopkinson's dental records finally were matched

through use of a new U.S. Army identification system made available to the Washington State Patrol.

Her dental chart had been entered into the National Crime Information Computer, but it failed to match her dental records to her name.

On Tuesday, Haglund contacted Dr. Gary Bell, a forensic dental adviser to the State Patrol, to see if the new Army software, Computer-Aided Post-Mortem Identification, could help.

Ironically, Bell was looking for a good test case. He ran the information from the Kittitas County murder case and came up with Hopkinson's name.

In Snohomish County, officials said the investigation of Lee's death was complicated by the discovery of body parts of at least two other victims.

Pieces of hair and scalp were found a day before Lee's skull was discovered in the same area, and in February, a man's leg was found near Startup.





The car dealership had several cars stolen during the two months worked there. A 2000 Cadillac Escalade and a 1999 Ford Mustang came up missing and the keys were gone from the key board as well. The sales staff assumed that the keys had either been left in the car or taken from the board. The keys to all of the cars were kept on a hanging board in the sales office and everybody had access. There was an open door policy on the keys because the sales staff had to unlock all of the cars in the morning and lock them all at closing time. All of the cars that were stolen were eventually recovered without any damage. A 2000 Chevy S-10 Blazer which was stolen from the lot was recovered by the police in Washington County and they were able to identify the person who stole it.

All of the sales staff kept folders at their desk containing customers' initial applications, "four square" sheets, Equifax Credit Bureau reports and other reference sheets. A "four square" sheet is the document sales people would use to "beat the people up". The form contained four boxes detailing the price of the vehicle, the customer's proposed down payment, the trade-in value of the customer's old vehicle and the customer's desired monthly payment.

If a customer was applying for financing from the folder would also contain a Package). This package consisted of detailed records regarding the customer's work history, residence history, mother's maiden name, social security numbers and other information. The sales staff used the folders to contact customers who had come into the dealership and provided personal information in order to make a purchase but had either not qualified to buy a car or chose not to buy a car at that time. Customer records from the previous thirty-five to forty days were kept in order by date in a filing cabinet in the sales managers' office. The sales managers required the sales staff to conduct these "follow-up" contact calls and often handed out stacks of folders from a filing cabinet.

The sales staff was not prohibited from bringing bags or briefcases into the dealership and it would be very easy to leave the building with customer folders. Each salesperson had a drawer in a desk where they put their personal items during working hours and no one "would even look at you" if you put something in a bag or briefcase.

There was nothing to indicate that two sets were received. | stated that none of the stolen cars had been damaged, so a key must have been used. b7C b6 was a salesman for As a salesman, the b7C person would come into the managers office with an application containing financial information provided by the customer. manager would run a credit check through Equifax, and then the manager would take the credit report out to the customer and talk to them about the possible sale. If there was derogatory information that came back from the credit check, the manager would typically have the salesman take the report out to the customer to inquire why the mortgage payment was late, for example. If there

were additional financial questions, the manager would call the bank to answer questions on credit. Management guides the salesmen to obtain what is needed from the customer.

A credit check is run on anyone who makes an offer, even if it's paid for by cash or check, to ensure credit history and that they have sufficient funds available. If the customer was unable to purchase a car, the application and credit report are placed in the "no-close" box in the sales office. The salesmen would go into the no-close box periodically and pull the customers they had. The salesmen would use those reports to follow up with the customers at a later date to see if they were still interested in buying a car. The salesmen could pull the files during their shift, but had to return them at the end of the day. Salesmen were not permitted to keep the files at their desk overnight. The files were sorted by salesman; however, after every month, the records were purged from the cabinet and sent to storage, and are no longer arranged by sales person.
