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



In September, 2001, an inventory of the 90th SFS Supply Room discovered a second set of the same model NVGs, serial #02324, missing. 08/31/2001, USAF investigators learned that on or about 08/20/2001, USAF Airman told h<u>is co-workers</u> that in order to pay off a debt to Airman gave him a set of NVGs that stole from the supply room was working. then sold the NVGs over the where Internet, through the E-Bay auction website. told USAF investigators that had lived with him, in government quarters, on FEWAFB for about a month in March-April, 2001, until | was discharged (for from the USAF. 




