Bureau indices also reveal that FRIEDMAN, on February 27, 1984, contacted the Chief of Freedom of Information Privacy Acts (FOIPA) Section, Records Management Division of the FBI and requested information regarding weekly intelligence conferences with the Air Force and related items. He also requested material dealing with a proposed study of flying saucers. At the time FRIEDMAN made this request, he provided specific file numbers of FBIHQ files in which this information was contained. It is not known how FRIEDMAN obtained these file numbers.

On February 20, 1985, the following agencies were requested to review pertinent data re FRIEDMAN's request and return the material as excised, citing the proper exemptions claimed, where appropriate, for release to FRIEDMAN: The Naval Investigative Service (NIS), the United States Army Intelligence and Security Command, and the Office of Special Investigations, Department of the Air Force.

Approximately one month ago, the information regarding FRIEDMAN's request was released to him. However, the context of that information has not yet been reviewed by this office. Boston will be advised of same when it becomes possible to do so.

At the time that Friedman made this request, the letter-head of his stationary read 31628 Trevor Avenue, Hayward, California, 94544, phone number (415) 471-0160.

Bureau indices also reveal that FRIEDMAN, on February 27, 1984, contacted the Chief of Freedom of Information Privacy Acts (FOIPA) Section, Records Management Division of the FBI and requested information regarding weekly intelligence conferences with the Air Force and related items. He also requested material dealing with a proposed study of flying saucers. At the time FRIEDMAN made this request, he provided specific file numbers of FBIHQ files in which this information was contained. It is not known how FRIEDMAN obtained these file numbers.

On February 20, 1985, the following agencies were requested to review pertinent data re FRIEDMAN's request and return the material as excised, citing the proper exemptions claimed, where appropriate, for release to FRIEDMAN: The Naval Investigative Service (NIS), the United States Army Intelligence and Security Command, and the Office of Special Investigations, Department of the Air Force.

Approximately one month ago, the information regarding FRIEDMAN's request was released to him. However, the context of that information has not yet been reviewed by this office. Boston will be advised of same when it becomes possible to do so.

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
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
