## FBI FOIPA Addendum

As referenced in our letter responding to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request, the FBI FOIPA Addendum provides information applicable to your request. Part 1 of the Addendum includes standard responses that apply to all requests. Part 2 includes standard responses that apply to requests for records about individuals to the extent your request seeks the listed information. Part 3 includes general information about FBI records, searches, and programs.

### Part 1: The standard responses below apply to all requests:

- (i) **5 U.S.C. § 552(c).** Congress excluded three categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIPA [5 U.S.C. § 552(c)]. FBI responses are limited to those records subject to the requirements of the FOIPA. Additional information about the FBI and the FOIPA can be found on the [www.fbi.gov/foia](http://www.fbi.gov/foia) website.
- (ii) **Intelligence Records.** To the extent your request seeks records of intelligence sources, methods, or activities, the FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), (b)(3), and as applicable to requests for records about individuals, PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(1), (b)(3), and (j)(2)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records is itself a classified fact protected by FOIA exemption (b)(1) and/or would reveal intelligence sources, methods, or activities protected by exemption (b)(3) [50 USC § 3024(i)(1)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that any such records do or do not exist.

### Part 2: The standard responses below apply to all requests for records on individuals:

- (i) **Requests for Records about any Individual—Watch Lists.** The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of any individual's name on a watch list pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(7)(E) and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that watch list records do or do not exist.
- (ii) **Requests for Records about any Individual—Witness Security Program Records.** The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records which could identify any participant in the Witness Security Program pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(3) and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(3), 18 U.S.C. 3521, and (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.
- (iii) **Requests for Confidential Informant Records.** The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of confidential informant records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(7)(D), (b)(7)(E), and (b)(7)(F) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552 (b)(7)(D), (b)(7)(E), and (b)(7)(F)] and Privacy Act exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. § 552a (j)(2)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records would reveal confidential informant identities and information, expose law enforcement techniques, and endanger the life or physical safety of individuals. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.

### Part 3: General Information:

- (i) **Record Searches and Standard Search Policy.** The Record/Information Dissemination Section (RIDS) searches for reasonably described records by searching systems, such as the Central Records System (CRS), or locations where responsive records would reasonably be found. The CRS is an extensive system of records consisting of applicant, investigative, intelligence, personnel, administrative, and general files compiled by the FBI per its law enforcement, intelligence, and administrative functions. The CRS spans the entire FBI organization, comprising records of FBI Headquarters, FBI Field Offices, and FBI Legal Attaché Offices (Legats) worldwide; Electronic Surveillance (ELSUR) records are included in the CRS. The standard search policy is a search for main entity records in the CRS. Unless specifically requested, a standard search does not include a search for reference entity records or administrative records of previous FOIPA requests.
  - a. *Main Entity Records* – created for individuals or non-individuals who are the subjects or the focus of an investigation
  - b. *Reference Entity Records* – created for individuals or non-individuals who are associated with a case but are not known subjects or the focus of an investigation
- (ii) **FBI Records.** Founded in 1908, the FBI carries out a dual law enforcement and national security mission. As part of this dual mission, the FBI creates and maintains records on various subjects; however, the FBI does not maintain records on every person, subject, or entity.
- (iii) **Foreseeable Harm Standard.** As amended in 2016, the Freedom of Information Act provides that a federal agency may withhold responsive records only if: (1) the agency reasonably foresees that disclosure would harm an interest protected by one of the nine exemptions that FOIA enumerates, or (2) disclosure is prohibited by law (5 United States Code, Section 552(a)(8)(A)(i)). The FBI considers this foreseeable harm standard in the processing of its requests.
- (iv) **Requests for Criminal History Records or Rap Sheets.** The Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division provides Identity History Summary Checks – often referred to as a criminal history record or rap sheet. These criminal history records are not the same as material in an investigative "FBI file." An Identity History Summary Check is a listing of information taken from fingerprint cards and documents submitted to the FBI in connection with arrests, federal employment, naturalization, or military service. For a fee, individuals can request a copy of their Identity History Summary Check. ## EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

### SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552

- (b)(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified to such Executive order;
- (b)(2) related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency;
- (b)(3) specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than section 552b of this title), provided that such statute (A) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on issue, or (B) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld;
- (b)(4) trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential;
- (b)(5) inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency;
- (b)(6) personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;
- (b)(7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information ( A ) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, ( B ) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, ( C ) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, ( D ) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, ( E ) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or ( F ) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

### SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552a

- (d)(5) information compiled in reasonable anticipation of a civil action proceeding;
- (j)(2) material reporting investigative efforts pertaining to the enforcement of criminal law including efforts to prevent, control, or reduce crime or apprehend criminals;
- (k)(1) information which is currently and properly classified pursuant to an Executive order in the interest of the national defense or foreign policy, for example, information involving intelligence sources or methods;
- (k)(2) investigatory material compiled for law enforcement purposes, other than criminal, which did not result in loss of a right, benefit or privilege under Federal programs, or which would identify a source who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(3) material maintained in connection with providing protective services to the President of the United States or any other individual pursuant to the authority of Title 18, United States Code, Section 3056;
- (k)(4) required by statute to be maintained and used solely as statistical records;
- (k)(5) investigatory material compiled solely for the purpose of determining suitability, eligibility, or qualifications for Federal civilian employment or for access to classified information, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(6) testing or examination material used to determine individual qualifications for appointment or promotion in Federal Government service the release of which would compromise the testing or examination process;
- (k)(7) material used to determine potential for promotion in the armed services, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished the material pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence.

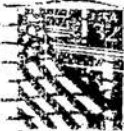

LETTER #1

**SINA BRUSH**

Just after dawn on September 5, 1991, some sixty agents from the DEA, U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (BATF), and National Guard, complete with painted faces and camouflage and accompanied by another twenty or more National Guard troops with a light armored vehicle, raided the homes of Sina Brush and two of her neighbors near Montclair, New Mexico. Brush and her daughter were still asleep. Hearing noises outside, Ms. Brush got up and was only halfway across the room, when the door was kicked in by the agents. Clad only in their underwear, Ms. Brush and her daughter were handcuffed and forced to kneel in the middle of the room while the agents searched the house. No drugs were found. Just as in the Carlson case, the police had obtained a warrant using information furnished by an unreliable informant and had entered Brush's home without knocking first.

**WACO**

This most notorious case has stunned the sensibilities of millions of Americans. According to The Wall Street Journal, "... the BATF showed up at the Davidian compound with two cattle trucks full of agents in battle gear and a plan for 'dynamic entry.' The siege that followed the initial assault included terrifying, psychological warfare tactics and ended when a second attack, utilizing tanks and gas, led to conflagration. 'Weird cultists' (your words) Some of the adults, but certainly not the children.

For two years now, thousands of calls and letters of outrage have been received by government, the media and yes, the NRA. The cries of "thugs"

"Nazi" and "storm trooper" came first, not from the NRA, but from the minds and mouths of Americans describing what they had seen on television.

**RANDY WEAVER**

This debacle at Ruby Ridge continues to fan a seething backlash in the country. A fourteen-year-old boy was shot in the back and killed. A mother was shot by a sniper in the head and killed while holding a baby. A jury found BATF guilty of entrapment and the defendant was acquitted. How does it all add up to justifiable behavior by, once again, black-shrouded forces with armored personnel carriers, helicopters and snipers all arrayed against a family in a cabin? Hundreds of good people have told me that scene reminds them of what this country once fought against and should never stand for.

Mr. President, there are more names and more abuse:

**JANICE HART**

**PORTLAND, OREGON  
FEBRUARY 1993**

Janice Hart pulled up to her house from grocery shopping with her daughters to find her house being ransacked by ATF agents who had kicked in the door. Agents searched her home, throwing dishes, pulling clothing from hangers and emptying drawers on the floor (she photographed the damage). Some eight ATF agents interrogated her in the basement for an hour before reading her her rights. She asked to call an attorney and the agents refused. When they finally asked her if she was Janice Marie Harrell, she told them no, that she was Janice Hart. ATF agents mocked her, accused her of selling firearms and cocaine, then arrested her. The Portland police, who she commended for their professional demeanor, took her downtown for booking and, within thirty seconds of fingerprinting her, realized ATF had the wrong person.

**LOUIS KATONA  
BUCYRUS, OHIO**

Louis Katona is a police officer in Bucyrus, Ohio. When shouting and cursing BATF agents rushed into his home to seize his firearms collection, they grabbed his pregnant wife, Kim, and shoved her into a wall. Within days, she suffered a miscarriage. A federal judge threw the government's case out of court and ordered BATF to immediately return Mr. Katona's guns or face jail themselves. The Katonas are presently pressing civil charges against BATF.

I could go on to tell you about Harry and Teresa Lamplugh, Ron and Elaine Miller, Howard and Sandy Wittenberg and many others. All victims of forceful, abusive and often vicious assaults on their homes and businesses by BATF agents who turned out not to have a case. You would hear about cancer medicines thrown all over the floor, family pets stomped to death, terrified children separated from their parents, tires slashed, threatening and hang-up telephone calls and other such behavior that has nothing to do with the America I grew up in. b6

I'm sorry that you have chosen to unequivocally condemn NRA's words without first seeking an explanation. Surely, a private exchange between us might persuade you to at least reserve a final opinion until all the facts are examined. Such a course of action, I believe, would have better served the country than what now will become a public disagreement that can only lead to more polarization in these troubled times.

Within hours of the bombing, NRA issued a statement declaring that "The National Rifle Association of America has nothing but contempt for terrorists or hate groups that attempt to disguise themselves as patriots." Deploing the monstrous act, we called for the death penalty for those found responsible, praised federal, state and local authorities and declared that law enforcement has "... no stronger ally than the NRA."

On January 10, 1994, the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), the NRA and other organizations appealed to President Clinton for the appointment of a national commission to "... investigate serious allegations of abuse by federal law enforcement agencies and to recommend steps that must be taken to reduce constitutional and human rights violations by federal law enforcement personnel." Citing "... serious allegations of abuse, including the improper use of deadly force ...," our letter offered specific examples of black-suited, masked, massively armed mobs of screaming, swearing agents invading the homes of innocents:

### DONALD CARLSON

On August 25, 1992 at about 10:30 p.m., Donald Carlson returned to his home in Poway, California, opened his garage door with a remote control device, simultaneously illuminating the garage so that Drug Enforcement Administration agents conducting surveillance from nearby could see inside. Just after midnight, when Carlson was asleep, a group of DEA agents burst into his house. Thinking they were robbers, Carlson grabbed his pistol to defend himself. He also dialed 911 for help. The agents shot Carlson three times, twice after he was down and clearly disabled.

Carlson spent seven weeks in intensive care, fighting for his life. No drugs were found on the premises.

It was later learned that the Federal Customs Service, the DEA and the U.S. Attorney's Office in San Diego had relied on an informant who was known to be untrustworthy and who claimed Carlson's garage contained 2,500 kilograms of cocaine (a large amount which would have taken up most of the garage) and four armed guards. The agents conducted the raid in spite of the fact they could see the informant's information was erroneous.

As of this writing, none of the federal agents involved in the incident have been sanctioned nor has Mr. Carlson been compensated for his injuries.

If all the above is not bad enough, just 62 days ago, on Wednesday, March 18, 1995, USA Today reported that "... a group of black agents has sued the 4,200-employee agency (BATF), charging widespread discrimination." The special agent in charge of ATF's Houston office, Donnie Carter, said, "There's institutional racism ... inside BATF." The article continues: "The suit charges ATF officials have routinely ignored racial abuses while funneling blacks into low-paying, but dangerous street assignments with little career potential. The black agents' legal documents cite numerous racial problems, including how: White agents in Oklahoma City in 1991 plastered their walls with a Confederate flag, a 'State of Oklahoma Nigger-Hunting License,' and a Ku Klux Klan business card. Black agents at the ATF office in Chicago in 1991 went to the photocopier and found a picture of civil rights activist Jesse Jackson with the words 'jungle bunny' scrawled on it."

Mr. President, if you watched any of NRA's recent appearances on national television, you know that we did not use this article to deflect criticism of our own language. Nor did we refer to the "60 Minutes" report that appeared on Sunday, January 12, 1993 in which female BATF agents themselves described a sickening pattern of sexual harassment, intimidation and retaliation in their own ranks. One agent reported, "I was held against the hood of my car and my clothes ripped off by two agents." Another said a male agent had "... repeatedly left dildoes on my desk." She then reported that, "... he trapped me in a room and told me he would screw me in a New York minute."

A male BATF agent who had come forward to support the charges of the female agents summed it up this way: "They violate the basic principles and tenets of the Constitution and the laws and simple ethics of morality. That's what disgusts me."

Just last Thursday, May 4, The New York Times, in an editorial stated that BATF "... has had its share of problems, including inexcusable errors leading up to the tragedy at Waco." The editorial went on to say that BATF "... is badly in need of internal reform. Waco was merely the most spectacular in a series of lapses in which the BATF became too aggressive. ..." They referred to BATF's "... woeful record of sex and racial discrimination." They said, "BATF is struggling with a legacy of mismanagement and large, visible mistakes that have undermined the public's confidence in its ability to do its job." And finally, the editorial declared that, "... if the agency is to survive, it must face its demons." Toward that end, the editorial concluded that congressional hearings "... can serve a useful purpose." That is exactly what NRA, ACLU, BATF's victims and millions of concerned citizens have been demanding for the last two years.

The same editorial reminded its readers that "Representative John Dingell has called its agents 'jack-booted American fascists' and Representative Harold Volkmer has called BATF 'one of the most Rambo-rogue law enforcement agencies in the United States.'"

Let me also call to your attention that the last time BATF abuses were investigated was in hearings before the Subcommittee on Treasury, Post Office and General Appropriations of the Senate Appropriations Committee in July 1979 and April 1980, and before the Subcommittee on the Constitution of the Senate Judiciary Committee in October 1980. They concluded, "Based upon these hearings it is apparent that enforcement tactics made possible by current federal firearms laws are constitutionally, legally, and practically reprehensible. ... These practices, amply documented in hearings before this Subcommittee, leave little doubt that the Bureau has disregarded rights guaranteed by the Constitution and laws of the United States ... It has trampled upon the Second Amendment by chilling exercise of the right to keep and bear arms by law-abiding citizens. ... It has offended the Fourth Amendment by unreasonably searching and seizing private property. ... It has ignored the Fifth Amendment by taking private property without just compensation and by entrapping honest citizens without regard for their right to due process of law. ... The rebuttal presented to the Subcommittee by the Bureau was utterly unconvincing. ... Evidence was submitted establishing that approximately 75 percent of BATF gun prosecutions were aimed at ordinary citizens who had neither criminal intent nor knowledge. ..."

Following the lead of the Senate, it was the Reagan-Bush Administration that cracked down on BATF and cleaned up the way they conducted themselves throughout the ensuing decade. Have you forgotten, President Bush, your previous passion for justice and fairness for all law-abiding citizens?

Once the Military Government is setup,

The facts are there, Mr. President. No American citizen can be proud of this agency's record in the last four years. Certainly, there are many fine, professional and heroic BATF agents who have served our nation with great distinction during this period, but their professionalism and honor are being overwhelmed by an increasingly angry and outraged American public that will not tolerate fear of their own government. That's why The Wall Street Journal, in an editorial last Tuesday, May 2, 1995 said "... recent history suggests that the people in charge of this country's system of law, order and justice had better get their acts together pretty darn quick." And, in a little-noted and largely ignored Time/CNN poll conducted eight days after the bombing in Oklahoma City, fifty-two percent of those questioned agreed that "... the federal government has become so powerful that it poses a threat to the rights and freedoms of citizens." That so many Americans actually fear their own government is a storm cloud on this country's horizon of unimaginable proportions.

Are the NRA's words to blame? Are John Dingell's? Is it the rhetoric of Rush Limbaugh or Bill Clinton or David Letterman? I don't think so. I believe more and more Americans see an emerging double standard that disgusts them. Again, I quote from The Wall Street Journal editorial of May 2, 1995, "Allowing for the dilemmas of the real world, we seem to have a double standard today. It says that law enforcement officials can do what they want with unpopular defendants like religious fanatics and white supremacists. But in dealing with suspects who might charge racial prejudice, they have to be careful indeed. Even in the wake of Oklahoma City, we are about to have the release of a Mario Van Peebles film making the Black Panthers into entertainment, guns and all."

President Bush, NRA never intended for its words to offend your sense of decency and honor or your concept of service to country. I firmly believe that after a thorough congressional examination of BATF, you will agree that our words have been more truth than slander. I believe you will judge too much of what BATF has done to be inexcusable and deserving of your personal repudiation. Therefore, I respectfully ask you to reconsider your resignation as a Life Member of the National Rifle Association until all the facts are known. Then, if you still feel that NRA has been wrong in the way it has confronted this issue, NRA will deserve your resignation. Until then, I believe we and the American people deserve your help in getting to the truth.

Republican and Democratic  
Senate leaders, returning to  
Washington in the wake of the  
Oklahoma City bombing, have  
pushed anti-terrorism legisla-  
tion to the top of their agenda.

President Clinton on Sunday  
called for tough, sweeping  
measures giving the FBI broad-  
er powers to investigate sus-  
pected terrorists.

But despite overwhelming  
support for anti-terrorism bills,  
civil liberties groups charged  
that constitutional rights could  
be trampled in the rush to re-  
spond to the deadly bombing.

Clinton's key proposals  
would:

► Create a domestic coun-  
terterrorism center run by the  
FBI.

► Prevent individuals who  
support or engage in terrorism  
from entering the United  
States. Allow the secretary of  
State to withhold visas for those  
suspected of coming from  
countries where there's a histo-  
ry of terrorism.

► Give the FBI greater sur-  
veillance power and easier ac-  
cess to telephone, credit and  
hotel records.

Arab-Americans and other  
ethnic groups are opposing pro-  
visions they consider biased  
against them — mainly two  
items Clinton outlined:

► A ban on contributions to  
organizations deemed by the  
president to be terrorist —  
without a special license from  
the Treasury secretary — even  
if the contribution is intended  
for peaceful purposes.

Opponents say that under-  
mines the First Amendment  
right to free association and  
gives the president too much  
power to say who is a terrorist.

► Allowing deportation  
judges to use classified evi-  
dence. Critics say that violates  
the 14th Amendment right to  
due process.

House Speaker Newt Ging-  
rich said Congress may need a  
new oversight committee "like  
the Intelligence Committee" in  
order to ensure federal law en-  
forcement agencies don't  
abuse powers they are expect-  
ed to receive.

The purpose of the legisla-  
tion is to "preserve freedom,  
not eliminate it," he said.

"I don't think you can lightly  
just say we're going to give the  
FBI this power. But... we have  
to have an ability to protect  
ourselves," he said.

Arab-American leaders met  
with Justice Department offi-  
cials Monday and will submit  
proposed revisions to the bill.

Had the bill been in effect  
when the Oklahoma bombing  
occurred, they say, Abraham  
Ahmad, an American citizen  
detained in Chicago and Lon-  
don as a potential suspect —  
then cleared — could have  
been deported.

The price of removing re-  
straints on the government  
frightens James Zogby, presi-  
dent of the Arab American In-  
stitute. He says he isn't con-  
vinced that the FBI ought to be  
trusted to determine how to en-  
sure political rights.

"They weren't up to the chal-  
lenge before and they're not  
ready for the challenge today,"  
says Zogby. "We have been vic-  
tims of the FBI's overzealous-  
ness in the past."

Because Arab Americans  
spoke out against U.S. policies  
in Lebanon, he says, they be-  
came targets of surveillance  
and harassment.

"We had late-night FBI visi-  
tations. They were interview-  
ing our neighbors. They were  
talking to our children's friends  
in school," he says. "That kind  
of stuff has been our experi-  
ence and we're not ready to re-  
live it."

But civil libertarians are  
quick to caution about threats  
to rights of privacy, free  
speech and freedoms taken for  
granted in a nation coming to  
grips with domestic terror.

"What we're afraid of is that  
history is once again repeating  
itself," says Phil Guts of the  
American Civil Liberties  
Union. "During many times of  
fears and tragedy, we have  
seen the government harass  
and investigate and arrest in-  
nocent people solely because  
of their race, religion, origin,  
and political beliefs."

"It's the ACLU's fear that we  
are about to embark down that  
road again."

After the political and consti-  
tutional outcry against FBI  
abuses, many uncovered after  
the death of Director J. Edgar  
Hoover in 1972, Congress strict-  
ly limited how far the agency  
could go in trying to infiltrate  
groups and investigate individ-  
uals deemed to be a threat to  
the nation's security.

The FBI couldn't get wire-  
taps, open mail, monitor com-  
puter messages or go under-  
cover unless the agency could  
prove the target was engaged  
in criminal activity and vio-  
lence.

Civil libertarians hailed the  
restrictions, but law enforce-  
ment agencies say the wall of  
obstacles made FBI agents shy  
away from investigating  
groups — such as the hundreds  
of militias that have been arm-  
ing themselves.

When the guidelines were  
enacted in April 1976, there  
were 4,868 domestic security  
investigations pending in the  
intelligence division of the FBI.

Less than six months later,  
there were only 626. By August  
1982, there were 38.

FBI agents — fearful of  
prosecution and angry over be-  
ing tarred as "nearly as bad as  
the Gestapo" — began to send  
their domestic cases back

The attitude became, "Why  
should we do intelligence  
work if the government is go-  
ing to indict us?" says Robert  
Heibel, former deputy chief of  
counterterrorism.

Former attorney general  
Bill Barr says that during the  
Bush administration, "We were  
concerned about extreme  
right-wing groups in the coun-  
try, but the surveillance and in-  
vestigation of these groups was  
not as thorough as it should  
have been because of domestic  
restrictions."

Now, says former FBI deputy  
director for investigations  
Oliver "Buck" Revell, "if we  
are unsuccessful in preventing  
significant acts of terrorism be-  
cause of a failure to take pru-  
dent precautions, the ensuing  
public demand for action could  
result in Draconian measure."

"We in Israel have gotten  
used to (terror)," says Ariel  
Merari, a terrorist expert at  
Tel Aviv University. "You must  
learn that whatever you do,  
there is no foolproof answer.  
(But) if you harden everything  
in an attempt to combat terror,  
you have a police state."

Those who recall an FBI lad-  
en with abuses have similar  
concerns.

In addition to investigations  
of civil rights and anti-war  
groups in the 1960s and 1970s,  
they cite as an example the in-  
vestigation of the Committee in  
Solidarity with the People of El  
Salvador in the 1980s.

"They were investigated under  
the rubric of terrorism and it  
extended to over 100 organi-  
zations. A third were churches  
and church groups. A third  
were student campus organiza-  
tions. And not one was engaged  
in criminal activity," says Da-  
vid Cole, constitutional law pro-  
fessor at Georgetown Universi-  
ty Law Center.

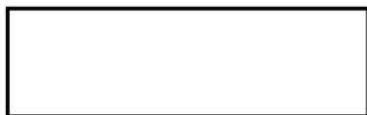

The following information is being provided pertaining to [REDACTED] who is the subject of an FBI investigation for making threats directed toward a United States Supreme Court Justice and two Federal judges:

FBI Birmingham advised that approximately two weeks ago a twelve page letter was sent to a number of businesses in the Birmingham, Alabama area, to include: a dairy, a bank, and a car dealership. There were no threats reported in these letters, which were identical, however, [REDACTED] vehicle registration was included with the letters.

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FBI Birmingham advised that on 01/08/1998, two Federal judges in Birmingham, Alabama, received hand written letters from [redacted] in which he indicated that he was going to firebomb the judges and burn-up their wives.

On 01/08/1998, the United States Attorney's Office (UASO) verbally authorized the FBI to arrest [REDACTED] On 01/08/1998, [REDACTED] was arrested by the FBI, without incident, at a restaurant near his residence in Birmingham, Alabama. FBI Birmingham also conducted a search of [REDACTED] residence, which produced no items of significance.

On 01/09/1998, FBI Birmingham filed a complaint in the United States District Court charging [REDACTED] with one count of Title 18, United States Code (USC), Section 115, for his threats to impede and intimidate federal officials. [REDACTED] has been ordered to be detained until such time that he is released for a psychiatric evaluation.

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FBI Birmingham advised that [redacted] has never acted out any of his threats in the past. [redacted] has been admitted numerous times to the [redacted] located in Alabama, and has been diagnosed in the past as a [redacted]

believes that there is a conspiracy to poison him

FBI Birmingham advised that [redacted] has a long history with law enforcement and does not currently have any weapons, vehicles, driver's license, or the financial resources to carry out any of his threats. [redacted] does not have any relatives or friends that have been identified in the Birmingham, Alabama.

[redacted] was scheduled for release back to custody of U.S. Marshals, Birmingham, in September or October of 1998. Prior to release, [redacted] psychiatric condition was determined to have deteriorated, and he was ordered to be provided continued treatment. [redacted] continues to face federal charges at Birmingham.

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Investigation at Birmingham has determined that [redacted] has limited financial means, living in a house inherited from his deceased parents. [redacted] exists on a small disability check, such that he could not likely afford to travel from Birmingham via public transportation. [redacted] walks wherever he goes, and has no drivers license. [redacted] has one brother, who was contacted and was completely cooperative. The brother lives in another state, and has limited contact with him, mostly because of [redacted] mental state. Neighbors surrounding [redacted] residence were contacted and advised that [redacted] has written letters prolifically to all of them over the course of the last several years. None of those interviewed could recall an incident of overt actions by [redacted] to accompany his letters, which were never directly threatening, but rather make references to death and assassination, etc.. [redacted] is universally acknowledged to be irrational and argumentative, but no one would go as far as saying they thought he could harm them.

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Birmingham Police are familiar with [redacted] He has been arrested by BPD on a number of prior occasions for minor offenses of disorderly conduct, which revolve around his being unwelcome in various public places due to his appearance and hygiene. Mention of BPD and other local officials in [redacted] letters is discounted by BPD as non-threatening.

A search warrant was executed at [redacted] residence, 1/10/98. No weapons were located during the search. WFO will be advised of continuing developments in this matter.

Result of examination:

Specimens Q1, Q2, Qc4 and Qc5 were compared with specimens in the Anonymous Letter File but no identifications were effected. Representative photographs will be added to the file for future reference.

The examinations of Q1 through Q3 failed to reveal any indented writing of significance, watermarks or other significant features which might be of assistance in determining the immediate source of those items. Perforations were noted along the upper edge of the Q2 sheet of paper, indicating that Q2 originated from a tablet or pad of paper.

It was determined that the questioned handwriting on Q1, Q2, and Qc5 was prepared by [redacted] b6  
FBI [redacted] whose known writings consist of signatures on b7C  
fingerprint cards and specimens K1 and Kc2. Those writings are not sufficiently comparable with the questioned handwriting on Qc4 for meaningful comparisons or any conclusions. Additionally, the Qc4 photocopy does not reproduce the original document with sufficient clarity for adequate handwriting comparison purposes. From such limited comparisons as could be made significant similarities were noted in comparing the questioned handwriting on Qc4 with the writings of [redacted]

The submitted specimens were photographed. Specimens Qc4, Qc5 and Kc2 are returned herewith. Specimens Q1 through Q3 and K1 will be returned to San Antonio with the results of the latent fingerprint examinations.

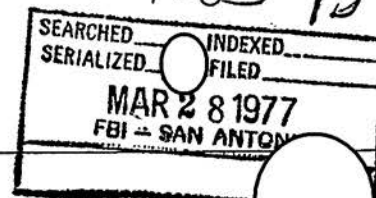

## Man is guilty of Mondale threat

A federal court jury deliberated for just 20 minutes Wednesday before finding John W. DeShazo guilty of mailing a letter threatening Vice President Walter Mondale.

DeShazo, 39, of 215 W. Laurel Ave., testified he mailed the threatening letter, but he did not mean to harm Mondale.

Mondale was campaigning for election when DeShazo mailed the letter last Nov. 1.

DeShazo mailed the letter from Bexar County Jail. He had been arrested in late October on a charge of writing a letter threatening then-candidate for president Jimmy Carter.

That charge was dropped, but DeShazo was arrested again Nov. 16 for the Mondale letter.

The letter was mailed to U.S. Magistrate Frank J. Baskin.

### Punish self

DeShazo said he knew he would be arrested for writing the letter but he wanted to punish himself.

DeShazo was released from federal prison at Leavenworth, Kan., in February 1975, after serving more than seven years.

He was convicted of threatening to kill President Johnson in 1968 and then of mailing a similar threat to kill former President Nixon in 1972, while still in prison.

U.S. Dist. Judge John H. Wood Jr. deferred sentencing until a report is prepared by the U.S. Probation Office.

# Guilty Verdict

A San Antonio man charged with mailing a letter with a message threatening Vice President Walter Mondale last November, has been found guilty by a federal jury in U.S. district court.

Sentencing for John Wesley DeShazo, 38, who formerly resided at a W. Laurel Street address, was deferred Wednesday by Federal Judge John H. Wood Jr., until he obtains a pre-sentence report.

DeShazo had previously been convicted of making threats against then President-elect Jimmy Carter and U.S. Sen. Lloyd Bentsen.

DeShazo was arrested by FBI and Secret

Service agents after he Mondale and U.S. Sen. allegedly mailed Robert Dole in November lettersthreatening 1976.
