FBI FOIPA Addendum

As referenced in our letter responding to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request, the FBI FOIPA Addendum provides information applicable to your request. Part 1 of the Addendum includes standard responses that apply to all requests. Part 2 includes standard responses that apply to requests for records about individuals to the extent your request seeks the listed information. Part 3 includes general information about FBI records, searches, and programs.

Part 1: The standard responses below apply to all requests:

- (i) **5 U.S.C. § 552(c).** Congress excluded three categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIPA [5 U.S.C. § 552(c)]. FBI responses are limited to those records subject to the requirements of the FOIPA. Additional information about the FBI and the FOIPA can be found on the www.fbi.gov/foia website.
- (ii) Intelligence Records. To the extent your request seeks records of intelligence sources, methods, or activities, the FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), (b)(3), and as applicable to requests for records about individuals, PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(1), (b)(3), and (j)(2)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records is itself a classified fact protected by FOIA exemption (b)(1) and/or would reveal intelligence sources, methods, or activities protected by exemption (b)(3) [50 USC § 3024(i)(1)]. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records which could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any incarcerated individual pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.

Part 3: General Information:

- (i) Record Searches. The Record/Information Dissemination Section (RIDS) searches for reasonably described records by searching systems or locations where responsive records would reasonably be found. A standard search normally consists of a search for main files in the Central Records System (CRS), an extensive system of records consisting of applicant, investigative, intelligence, personnel, administrative, and general files compiled by the FBI per its law enforcement, intelligence, and administrative functions. - (iii) Requests for Criminal History Records or Rap Sheets. The Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division provides Identity History Summary Checks often referred to as a criminal history record or rap sheet. These criminal history records are not the same as material in an investigative "FBI file." An Identity History Summary Check is a listing of information taken from fingerprint cards and documents submitted to the FBI in connection with arrests, federal employment, naturalization, or military service. - (iv) **National Name Check Program (NNCP).** The mission of NNCP is to analyze and report information in response to name check requests received from federal agencies, for the purpose of protecting the United States from foreign and domestic threats to national security. Please be advised that this is a service provided to other federal agencies. Private Citizens cannot request a name check.

EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552

- (b)(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified to such Executive order;
- (b)(2) related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency;
- (b)(3) specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than section 552b of this title), provided that such statute (A) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on issue, or (B) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld;
- (b)(4) trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential;
- (b)(5) inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency;
- (b)(6) personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;
- (b)(7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

- (k)(5) investigatory material compiled solely for the purpose of determining suitability, eligibility, or qualifications for Federal civilian employment or for access to classified information, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(6) testing or examination material used to determine individual qualifications for appointment or promotion in Federal Government service the release of which would compromise the testing or examination process;
- (k)(7) material used to determine potential for promotion in the armed services, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished the material pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence.

Investigation revealed that vehicle number one was slowing for traffic when an unknown brown vehicle struck vehicle number one in the rear, causing the operator of vehicle number one to loose control, crossing into the south bound lane STRIKING VEHICLE number two in the left front. Further investigation revealed evidence to prosecute in the District of Columbia.

For information of WFO, the vehicle in which Mayor CAZARES was riding at the time of the alleged hit-and-run accident was described as a small foreign sports car, convertible, and red in color. Mayor CAZARES did not know the make of the automobile but indicated the only vehicle involved was the one in which he was a passenger.

CAZARES claimed that while driving through a park, believed to be Rock Creek Park, and traveling at a speed of approximately 25-30 miles per hour, he heard a thump in the vicinity of the driver's side of the car. Just prior to hearing the noise, he had observed a figure, possibly that of a man, walking alongside of the road. He did not see the woman driving the car hit anything nor did he feel the car lurch. He merely heard the thumping sound.

Since the accident report enclosed with re WFO airtel involved two vehicles, it is apparent that this is not identical with the incident to which CAZARES referred.




Enclosed for Los Angeles are two copies of referenced report which is dated 10/27/76 and appears to relate to the SITOL special.

For the information of Los Angeles, Clearwater, Florida is the headquarters for the Church of Scientology Sea Organization. Approximately two years ago, the Church of Scientology purchased the former Fort Harrison Hotel located in downtown Clearwater. At the time of this purchase, there was a considerable amount of discussion in regard to the name of the purchaser which was originally.

It was subsequently determined that the United Churches of Florida, Inc., was a front type organization for the Church of Scientology. The hotel was purchased for approximately 1.5 million dollars in cash and was considered to be a landmark in the downtown Clearwater, Fla., area. It is estimated the Ft. Harrison Hotel has approximately 200 rooms.

Following the sale of this hotel and the unusual circumstances surrounding its purchase by the Church of Scientology, Clearwater, Fla., residents including Mayor GABRIEL CAZARES, frequently expressed in public and on radio talk shows his apprehensions regarding the Church of Scientology's status as a "church" and his general displeasure with their presence in downtown Clearwater, Fla., and their tax exempt status. Following the public statements of CAZARES against the Church of Scientology, the Scientologists publicly took issue with CAZARES's statements and filed various law suits against him. CAZARES immediately filed counter suits which apparently have recently been dropped by mutual consent after several court appearances, depositions, and other legal proceedings.

met by an unidentified reporter and subsequently by a woman

In July of 1976, prior to the Fall Mayoral elections, various members of the Pinellas County Democratic Party received anonymous letters signed, which insinuated immoral conduct by CAZARES during his visit to Washington, D. C. and illegal conduct in failing to report the aforementioned accident. It is noted that these letters apparently did not serve the purpose of discrediting GABRIEL CAZARES with the Pinellas County





Scientologists seek \$1 from McMurtry over raid warrant

By ROBERT STEPHENS

The Church of Scientology of Toronto has filed a writ seeking \$1 in damages against Ontario Attorney-General Roy McMurtry and a justice of the peace for allegedly refusing to provide church officials with a copy of the search warrant used in a raid earlier this year.

A statement of claim filed yesterday in the Supreme Court of Ontario alleges that the church's rights to be free from unreasonable search and seizure were violated. It also claims there was a breach of statutory duty under the Criminal Code and an excess of government pow-

Earl Smith, vice-president of the church, said in an interview that the Scientologists are seeking only \$1 in damages because "we're doing this on principle and not for some personal advantage."

About 100 Ontario Provincial Police officers, some carrying sledgehammers and fire extinguishers, raided the church's headquarters on Yonge Street on March 3. They seized and removed approximately 250,000 pages of documents.

The statement of claim says the church was not provided with a copy of the warrant at the time of

It also states that Albin Kostecka, a justice of the peace and clerk of the Provincial Court at Old City Hall, refused to allow a lawyer for the church to inspect the warrant "even though he had such information in his custody at the time #1.450.

The statement of claim says "a servant or agent" of Mr. McMur. try, believed to be Harry Black of the Crown law office, instructed Mr. Kostecka to refuse to allow the !church to inspect the warrant.

The Scientologists eventually were allowed to see the warrant after winning a favorable decision in the Supreme Court of Ontario on March 7. Mr. Justice Allen Linden ruled that Ontario police forces were acting unlawfully in refusing to allow citizens to see search warrants used in investigations:

Judge Linden said the church had the right to see the warrant and the 1,000 pages of supporting information used to back the request for a warrant. The warrant was issued on the basis of statements given by Detective Sergeant Albert Ciampinit of the OPP In addition to the token amount of !

damages requested, the church is seeking a declaration that it had the right to immediately inspect the information backing the warrant.

The OPP has said the raid was part of a two-year investigation into income-tax payments and the cost of courses run by the Scientologists. The vast quantity of documents seized in the raid ranged from membership lists to financial re-

cords: A A Toronto lawyer Clayton Ruby. who is representing the church, said yesterday that no charges have been laid against the church.
