### FBI FOIPA Addendum

Part 3 includes general information about FBI records, searches, and programs.

#### Part 1: The standard responses below apply to all requests:

At the outset of the interview an "Advise of Rights and Waiver Form" was furnished to SCHMIDT; he acknowledged that he understood his rights and he signed the form.

SCHMIDT also acknowledged that he was already acquainted with SA SCHULER and SA HAINES.

SCHMIDT stated that he wrote a letter to Secretary of Defense MELVIN R. LAIRD in late February, 1972, in which he made threatening statements. He stated that at that particular time he had gotten upset over his job with Specialized Services in Alton, with the pay he was receiving and with other areas involving his occupation. He stated that whenever he becomes upset or gets tense he is inclined to write letters without any intention of carrying out the statements made therein. He stated that he does not own a weapon of any sort nor does he have any intention of harming anyone particularly the Secretary of Defense.

SCHMIDT was admonished concerning the sending of letters of this type and expressed the sincere determination not to repeat his offense.



A photostatic copy of this letter and envelope were searched through the Anonymous Letter File of the FBI Laboratory without effecting an identification.





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
