FBI FOIPA Addendum

As referenced in our letter responding to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request, the FBI FOIPA Addendum provides information applicable to your request. Part 1 of the Addendum includes standard responses that apply to all requests. Part 2 includes standard responses that apply to requests for records about individuals to the extent your request seeks the listed information. Part 3 includes general information about FBI records, searches, and programs.

Part 1: The standard responses below apply to all requests:

- (i) **5 U.S.C. § 552(c).** Congress excluded three categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIPA [5 U.S.C. § 552(c)]. FBI responses are limited to those records subject to the requirements of the FOIPA. Additional information about the FBI and the FOIPA can be found on the www.fbi.gov/foia website.
- (ii) Intelligence Records. To the extent your request seeks records of intelligence sources, methods, or activities, the FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), (b)(3), and as applicable to requests for records about individuals, PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(1), (b)(3), and (j)(2)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records is itself a classified fact protected by FOIA exemption (b)(1) and/or would reveal intelligence sources, methods, or activities protected by exemption (b)(3) [50 USC § 3024(i)(1)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that any such records do or do not exist.

- (iii) Requests for Records for Incarcerated Individuals. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records which could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any incarcerated individual pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.

- (i) Record Searches. The Record/Information Dissemination Section (RIDS) searches for reasonably described records by searching systems or locations where responsive records would reasonably be found. A standard search normally consists of a search for main files in the Central Records System (CRS), an extensive system of records consisting of applicant, investigative, intelligence, personnel, administrative, and general files compiled by the FBI per its law enforcement, intelligence, and administrative functions. The CRS spans the entire FBI organization, comprising records of FBI Headquarters, FBI Field Offices, and FBI Legal Attaché Offices (Legats) worldwide; Electronic Surveillance (ELSUR) records are included in the CRS. - (ii) **FBI Records.** Founded in 1908, the FBI carries out a dual law enforcement and national security mission. As part of this dual mission, the FBI creates and maintains records on various subjects; however, the FBI does not maintain records on every person, subject, or entity.
- (iii) Requests for Criminal History Records or Rap Sheets. The Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division provides Identity History Summary Checks often referred to as a criminal history record or rap sheet. These criminal history records are not the same as material in an investigative "FBI file." An Identity History Summary Check is a listing of information taken from fingerprint cards and documents submitted to the FBI in connection with arrests, federal employment, naturalization, or military service. - (iv) **National Name Check Program (NNCP).** The mission of NNCP is to analyze and report information in response to name check requests received from federal agencies, for the purpose of protecting the United States from foreign and domestic threats to national security. Please be advised that this is a service provided to other federal agencies. Private Citizens cannot request a name check.

EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552

- (b)(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified to such Executive order;
- (b)(2) related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency;
- (b)(3) specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than section 552b of this title), provided that such statute (A) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on issue, or (B) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld;
- (b)(4) trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential;
- (b)(5) inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency;
- (b)(6) personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;
- (b)(7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

- (k)(3) material maintained in connection with providing protective services to the President of the United States or any other individual pursuant to the authority of Title 18, United States Code, Section 3056;
- (k)(4) required by statute to be maintained and used solely as statistical records;
- (k)(5) investigatory material compiled solely for the purpose of determining suitability, eligibility, or qualifications for Federal civilian employment or for access to classified information, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(6) testing or examination material used to determine individual qualifications for appointment or promotion in Federal Government service the release of which would compromise the testing or examination process;
- (k)(7) material used to determine potential for promotion in the armed services, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished the material pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence.

want everybody to know it.") Demanding that the cameraman give him more party footage of frolicking thongs. Demanding Fiji water, not one sip from the myriad bottles of champagne in the room; he needs the energy to keep the party moving.

Diddy. — host of this year's Video Music Awards, entertainment mogul, pedigreed partyer, Star Island resident and Miami's brand-new face — is wearing a T-shirt with gold script letters, self-summary on his chest: "The Chosen One."

"I love Miami. The whole city has embraced me," he says, the room now so full of staff members and demands that he moves an interview into the cramped but private confines of the hotel bath. "This was one of the best moves of my life."

It is a transition that hasn't gone unnoticed. "You used to think of Miami as Diddy's playground," says Shaun Robinson, weekend co-anchor of Access Hollywood. "Now it's his home."

Diddy's well-chronicled connection to Miami actually factored in his selection as host of the MTV Video Music Awards, which makes its second splash at the American-Airlines Arena tonight. Officials lobbied hard to get MTV to return; Diddy, MTV execs say, helped lock it down.

"Diddy throws a great party. And Miami throws a great party. Diddy and Miami have a real special connection, and that is a huge asset to us," says Christina Norman, president of MTV. "Absolutely, it was part of our decision."

As long as Diddy can remember, he has played in Miami, seduced by its two-flavored tonic of edge and chill. But four years ago, after he was acquitted on charges surrounding a 1999 New York nightclub shooting, Combs

headed to the city with a different purpose: He was looking for a place to regroup without filters or judgment.

"It was an emotionally draining experience," Diddy says of the trial. "I have a family, three kids, and I could have lost my life for something I didn't do," he continues, his game face slightly off for the first time. "After that, I needed to get away. I didn't want to use a credit card, so I just jumped on a bus and came to Miami. I was looking for a fresh start."

IN LOVE WITH MIAMI

Thirteen hundred miles later, Diddy got off the bus and was met by a stranger. The guy just wanted to say hello to P. Diddy (after the trial, he shortened his name from Puff Daddy) and never once mentioned the trial. In that moment — the first time he truly believed there was life after courtroom hell —

Diddy says he fell in love with Miami. He hung out with friends here for six months, absorbing the city's culture. "That experience stayed with me," he says.

It would be several years before Diddy actually purchased a home on celebrity-studded Star Island. The \$18 million Balinese-style hacienda, appointed in dark exotic woods, perches on a private stretch along Biscayne Bay.

These days, Diddy spends a third of his time here. It's where he's thrown some of his most private affairs, including the Fabulous Fifty party, among the most coveted Video Music Awards events last year. But it's also where he began to try to define how he could make a difference in Miami.

"Now it's time for me to give back," he says. "You can't just stay on Star Island or party on the Beach. To whom much is given, much is

expected."

So Diddy — just Diddy since he stripped the moniker of extraneous abbreviations — has taken another step toward making his mark here in philanthropy, for a celebrity a powerful measure of community commitment.

"Right now, I am weeding through organizations to decide who to help or if I should start an organization of my own," he says. "I want to do something with children and education. Miami is nice and has the sexy beaches and clubs, but it also needs help."

Those who study entertainment stars are watching the dynamic brew: Diddy and his new city.

"Diddy, who walks in so many worlds, comes to your town, and he is obviously going to put his own spin on Miami, remix it culturally," says Farai Chideya, founder and editor of Pop and Politics, a website focusing on popular culture.

"But the real significance of his living there [part time] is if he really takes part in the life of Miami both civically and philanthropically. That is the real test."

A COMMUNITY PROGRAM

Within a year, Diddy says, he plans to announce a signature community program, not unlike his involvement in the New York City Marathon—he ran and raised \$2 million for needy children—or his national Vote or Die voterregistration program last year.

"I don't do anything halfassed, so I am taking my time," Diddy says. "I want to make sure it's good and it's positive."

But he counts the Video Music Awards as his first contribution to Miami: "The show coming here gives the city an extra injection. That is one of the reasons I wanted it to be here."

(U) Key Findings:

(U//FOUO) As of 23 August 2013, FBI New York has negative information to indicate a specific, credible threat to or associated with the MTV Video Music Awards being held in Brooklyn New York, 25 August 2013.

(U//FOUO) The New York Office is concerned about the sustained interest by terrorists, and criminals in targeting mass gatherings. Lone offenders and Homegrown Violent Extremists (HVEs) are of paramount concern given the expected crowd density within the Barclays Center, which would provide extremists an opportunity to perpetuate a mass casualty attack, as witnessed by the April 2013 Boston Marathon attacks. The NYO Intelligence Division (NYID) performed a search utilizing classified and unclassified databases to identify potential foreign counterintelligence, counterterrorism, and criminal threats, which yielded negative results as of 23 August 2013. The potential concerns for this event would be an assassination attempt on attendees as well as the individuals involved ie., athletes and event staff, a
