This letter is in reference to your Freedom of Information Act request dated 28 December 2021. We received your request and have assigned case number 2022-01246-F.

A review of the records you requested was conducted under the FOIA to determine if the documents you requested are releasable. After reviewing the documents it was determined that the documents are releasable, however, some information within the documents must be protected under the following 5 USC § 552 FOIA exemptions:

Exemption (b)(3), "Specifically exempted from disclosure by statute" IAW 10 U.S.C. § 130b. *Personnel in Overseas, Sensitive, or Routinely Deployable Units: Nondisclosure of Personally Identifying Information.*

Exemption (b)(6), "Personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy."

The FOIA provides for the collection of fees based on the costs of processing a FOIA request and your fee category. We have placed you in the "All Other" fee category, which entitles you to get the first 2 hours of search and the first 100 pages of reproductions free. The documents we are providing you contain a total of 22 pages. There will be no duplication charges for the 22 pages.

Should you decide that an appeal to this decision is necessary, you must write to the Secretary of the Air Force within 90 calendar days from the date of this letter. Include in your appeal any reasons for reconsideration you wish to present and attach a copy of this letter. The appeal should be forwarded to:

I ask the USAF to search all databases and systems for all responsive records. This requestor is unsure which service center to send this request to due to confusing acronyms for which the USAF does not have a public listing of. I am a member of the news media and request classification as such. I will be writing about the government and its activities as an independent journalist for the public at large via very public platforms with a potential reach of hundreds of millions. In addition, I will discuss and comment on the files online and intend to make them available through the non-profit Internet Archive, disseminating them to a large audience. While my research is not limited to this, a great deal of it, including this, focuses on the activities and attitudes of the government itself. As such, it is not necessary for me to demonstrate the relevance of this particular subject in advance. Additionally, case law states that "proof of the ability to disseminate the released information to a broad cross-section of the public is not required." Judicial Watch, Inc. v.
