Subject: Navies of DPRK and ROK exchange fire

SEOUL (AP) - Navy ships of the two Koreas exchanged fire November 10 along their disputed western sea border, South Korean military officers said.

A South Korean warship shot at a North Korean navy ship that crossed the disputed western sea border on the morning of November 10 and the North's ship shot back, said an officer at the Seoul's Joint Chiefs of Staff. Another officer said there were no South Korean casualties, though it was unclear whether there were any on the North Korean side. He said that the North Korean ship was seriously damaged and that it turned back toward northern waters after the brief skirmish. Both officers spoke on condition of anonymity, citing department policy.
