A few quick updates:

-- India: I spoke four times to Natl Sec Advisor Menon over the past couple days, and we have completed nuclear reprocessing agreement, as you promised PM Singh we would do late last year. US negotiating team on ground (led by Dick Stratford of ISN) and Tim Roemer deserve the credit. We need to conform texts and prepare for Congressional briefings before going public, but this is important step.

-- Turkey: Thanks again for your call to Berman, and FT statement. Jim Jeffery reports reaction in Turkey is tough, but so far along lines of previous episodes. FM made public statement keeping door open on Armenia. Gul conversation with Pres two days ago My Turkish counterpart still plans to go to Yerevan next week.

-- Indonesia: Call sheet is on its way to you for call to FM H is working to arrange your talk with Sen Leahy next week re Kopassus.

-- Russia: Followed up with Amb Kislyak and DFM Ryabkov on your call with Lavrov.
