I've attached Admiral Mullen's 2011 guidance that just came out today. He makes a direct reference to supporting implementation of the QDDR (in conflict prevention and response) on p. 6 at the bottom in the Conclusion. Just this line alone will result in a trickle down effect that will lead DoD and the military to look for our leadership and a more formal mechanism to support us in this area. Our implementation planning on conflict prevention and response would benefit from a very active effort and a more formal initiative to harness DoD. The final report makes room for this by making CSO a center for civil-military collaboration on conflict - but it does not say much more than that. So the details will need to be worked out in implementation planning.
