SRAP was able to connect with McConnell's senior staffer yesterday and spent about 2 hours briefing him on the state of play in Pakistan. The staffer started out by saying he'd give our policy in the region an "F" right now but by the end of the conversation had come around to our side. SRAP reported that it was heartening to see that their briefing had such an impact with the staffer and are looking to replicate this type of briefing with many of the new incoming staff and possibly members. We are consulting closely with SRAP to make sure that we've got a strong Leg plan to engage the hill and to make sure that we're effectively communicating our strategy and our successes.

For now I think our concerns related to their press posture have been addressed as best we can. Between the briefing and good work by the Embassy to have minimal press in the schedule, we look to be in good shape. Amb. Munter is still trying to connect with McConnell as a courtesy but I don't have any updates on whether they've had any luck with the visit and all this week.
