TEHRAN (AP) – Iran hanged two members of the opposition People's Mujahedeen convicted over the 2009 post-election turmoil. The official IRNA news agency said Jafar Kazemi and Mohammad Ali Hajaghaei were executed after an appeals court upheld their death sentences. It said they filmed and distributed footage of massive anti-government protests that swept Iran after the disputed presidential election in June 2009. The opposition contends Mahmoud Ahmadinejad won through ballot fraud.
