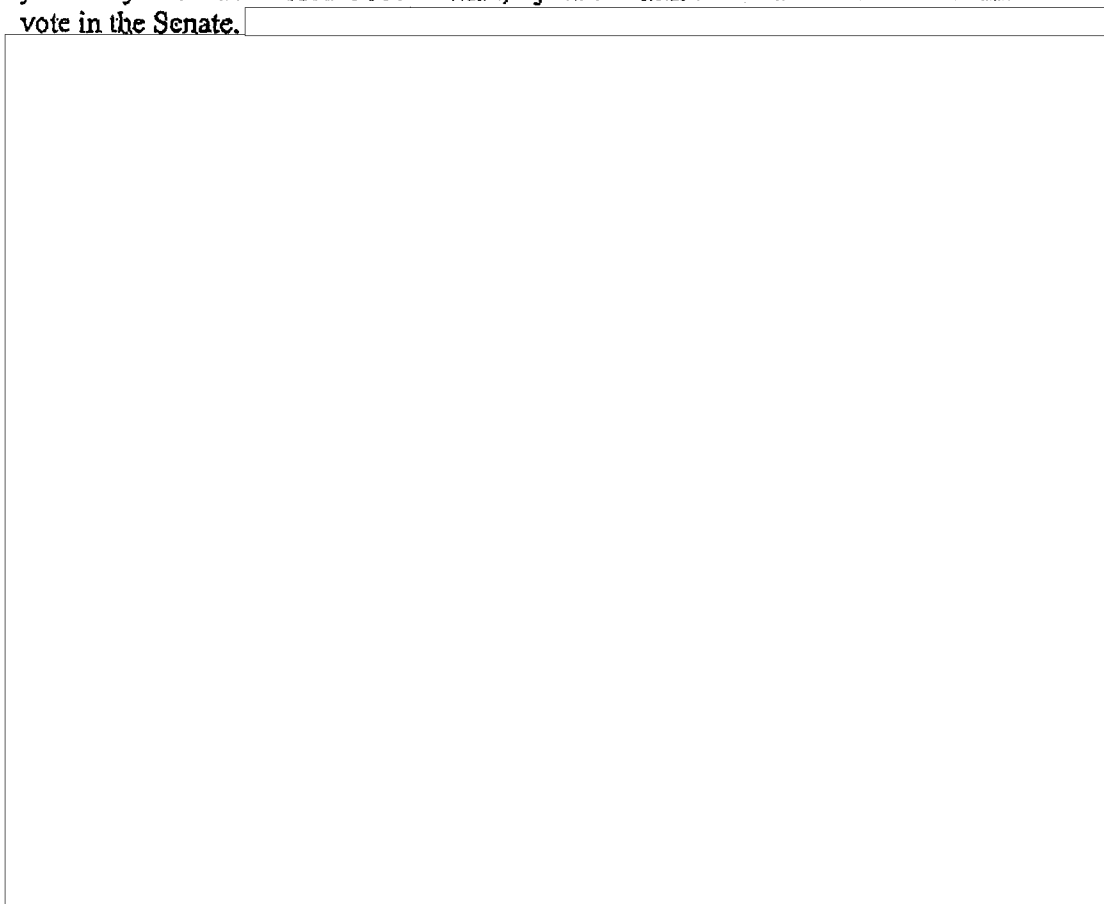

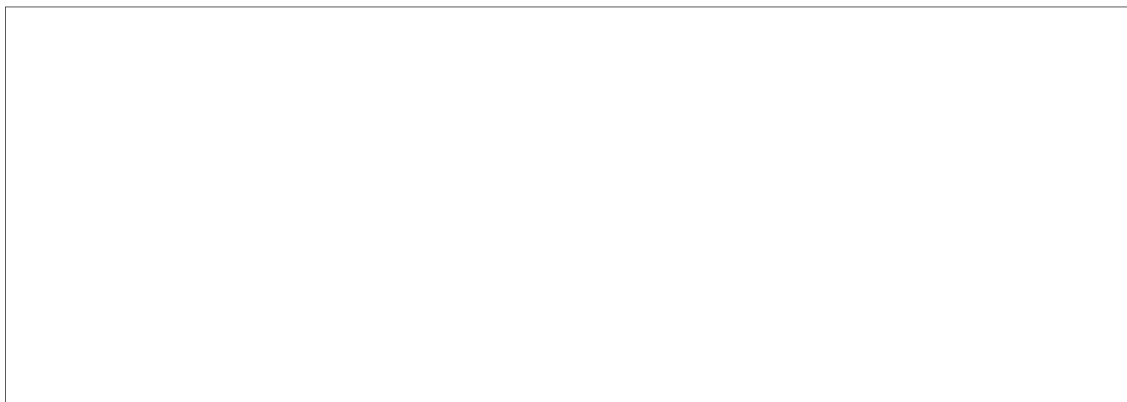
Dear Senator Chambliss and Senator Isakson:
