I know there are a lot of people who were involved in pushing and advocating for my release and I am looking forward to meeting all of them, but right now I would like to thank two people: Lorne Craner of IRI for not forgetting about me and constantly reminding his colleagues about my case, and Madam Secretary Hillary Clinton. I believe it was her personal involvement in my case that ensured my release. I am very touched that despite difficult geopolitical realities of Central Asia, Madam Secretary found time to bring up my case during her meeting with [President] Karimov. There is a third actor that I would to thank, too. It is the people of the United States of America. If it wasn't for the people of this great country, there wouldn't be individuals like Lorne Craner and Hillary Clinton, which would mean that people like me would be most likely to perish in dungeons of tyrants and dictators of this world. Only people as great as Americans could build a country that sees freedoms of other people and nations as important as their own. The U.S. saved me from death two times: in 2001, when I was arrested for criticizing the Uzbek government and now, when I was so close to death that I gave up all hope of seeing my family every again.
