(SBU) After our telephone conversation, I called MFA Director for North and Central America to explain that we needed a follow-up diplomatic note with the more comprehensive text provided by our Legal Advisor's office and forwarded to him after delivery of the demarche. I reiterated that the Ambassador-Designate should not travel to the States until we respond with our concurrence.
