1. Thursday, 7/28, there will be visitors to your place

It is Project Common Bond, run by Tuesday's Children (as in Tues 9/11), a program for young people from around the world whose lives have been specifically impacted by terrorism. The group includes several from 9/11 and a number from 10 other countries.
