In a shakeup of Washington's public-affairs elite, Donald A. Baer, White House communications director under President Bill Clinton and a longtime media executive, on Thursday was named global chief executive officer of Burson-Marsteller -- the top job at the public-relations giant. Baer succeeds Mark Penn, who is joining Microsoft Corp. as corporate vice president, strategic and special projects, according to the Burson-Marsteller announcement.
