It went very well. Rep. Cantor seemed very pleased to visit the three Caricol sites and took the most interest in the housing since he told us he has a professional background in doing legal work for land development projects. Thus establishing the site for the industrial development area also seemed the kind of project he was also familiar with and seemed very comfortable with the concept. He had very many straightforward questions about Hatian history, economics and had very comfortable conversations with contractors, the head of the Korean firm, and project managers. I think he was struck with local wage scales and praised the work he saw. We talked in passing about future local elections, the drug trade, security issues in port au prince, programs to stregthen the police. He immediatelly agreed that police numbers seemed low per capita. He came accross as truly interested in understanding Haiti better and complemented people throughout for their work.
