Our Ambassador spoke this afternoon to the Latvian Political Director and he said that Latvia does not have any concerns and in fact MFA is proposing that President Zatlers laud the new START in his remarks at UNGA
Lithuania:
Our A/DCM spoke this afternoon with the Lithuanian Political Director and the poldir expressed surprise that there was any question about Lithuanian support for START. They have no problems with START and welcome it. The poldir speculated that perhaps someone was conflating START with real Lithuanian concern over A/CFE (even as they welcome our strong consultation with them as the A/CFE process moves ahead).

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
