Cheryl:

I spoke with Simoes and passed on the message regarding the Secretary's trip to Haiti.

He noted that Tom Adams had mentioned the trip and asked whether or not Patriota might be able to travel to Haiti with the Secretary. At the time, Simoes said, he had declined saying that Patriota would be travelling with the new President to Argentina. However, Simoes told me that there is now a chance that the Brazilian President will not travel to Buenos Aires until Monday morning, which might open up the possibility of Patriota joining the Secretary in Haiti.

Simoes asked, "Please find out if the Secretary would still like Patriota to accompany her, and when she plans to arrive. If it is early enough, Patriota might be able to fly up and fly back on Sunday."

Simoes is still in Washington. He departs tonight. When I called him, he had just finished a meeting
