(SBU) Embassy Tunis comments the school's director reports the school is on fire. However, all students and staff were dismissed prior to the attack, and there is no one in the building at this time.

Embassy Tunis adds protesters have poured gasoline on part of the embassy compound wall. The embassy fire alarm has sounded, but this appears to be due to smoke coming from outside the compound. Media report armored vehicles and horse-mounted police are on site at the embassy.
