Iranian Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei's Friday sermon 9.00-10.00 gmt

In his Friday sermon, carried live on Al Alam, Ayatollah Khamenei made the following main points:

- praised the Tunisia and Egyptian people
- said President Mubarak was not only a tyrant but "an agent and servant of Zionism" who lays siege to Gaza
- There were reports Tunisian President Ben Ali was a CIA agent.
- Egypt was a leading Arab and Muslim state with a proud record opposing colonialism and Israel. But US control over Egypt's ruler had turned it into an "arch enemy of Palestine", while Syria had preserved its independent stance.
- The "miraculous event" began in Tunis and will culminate in "the great Egypt".
- If the Egyptian people manage to make advances this will be a huge defeat for the US.
