Subject: Updates

1. Wisner is talking [redacted] at 930 tonight. You're of course welcome to join (I think not necessary). I will join.
2. [redacted] He will leave around noon or 1.
3. One non-Egypt issue we need to nail down is this CBM business. Bibi clearly believes that if he does something – really anything – on CBMs, he's free and clear of other "U.S. initiatives." [redacted]
