Saudi resolution at UNGA on IRAN plot to kill the Saudi Ambassador to Washington:

Total: 106 Yes – 9 No – 40 Abstention
Africa: 17 Yes – 1 No – 8 Abstention, 23 absent

Co-Sponsors: CAR, Chad, Djibouti, Mauritania, Somalia, South Sudan.
