2. We all agree that kids should be a key focus and the best reason for any program is the moral importance. It's fine to acknowledge we do these programs for a variety of pragmatic reasons, but the most powerful reason is moral. It is the right thing to do.

3. We mostly all agree it is ok to spend money on these programs, but we should always note how we are fighting for reform too. The two concepts are not antagonists, but partners. And we are partners with other countries, this is not hand outs. There are mutual responsibilities.

4. Corruption is a major reason why people, rightly, think the programs don't work.

5. Even as folks are skeptical of the big promise, they still want us to try.
