As the attached indicates, Senator Lautenberg is holding up the Generalized Preferences bill that, if it expires, which it will on December 31 if it is not renewed early next week, 131 countries will see the tariffs on their imports to the US rise sharply and billions of dollars of their trade will be disrupted. The attached email from my counterpart at USTR describes the issue with Lautenberg. Ron Kirk would like the Secretary to call Lautenberg ASAP to urge him to drop his hold and assure him that we are doing all we can to secure the release of Sean Goldman. If the hold continues, we face an enormous foreign policy and economic disaster with virtually all of the world's developing nations.
