Report on the Goldman case and GSP

Thanks to the persistent efforts of our charge' in Brasilia, I was finally able to locate and call my counterpart, Under secretary Pedro Mendonca.

I made the points contained in your email to me -- and emphasized the seriousness of the issue and Sen. Lautenberg's frustration that despite the Mr. Goldman's victories in court, he is still unable to get his son back. I said that Lautenberg had told you that in light of this, he was continuing his hold on the GSP legislation -- which, if it continues, would harm Brazil and every other developing nation.

Pedro will speak to the acting foreign minister and other authorities in Brazil right now -- and will get back to me with an update and an assessment of what more can be done.

I have also spoken with my USTR counterpart Demetrios Marantis throughout the day. They have discussed this matter with the Brazilian charge' in DC. They had also organized the meeting between him and Lautenberg that Craig mentioned to you in his email -- hoping that it would lead to a lifting of the hold. Demetrios will consult with Ron Kirk to decide what more to do.

I will email you again as soon as I hear from Brasilia and/or USTR.

And I will continue to coordinate with Craig.
